RE: Bango Wind Farm SSD6686 - Condition 5 of Schedule 4 - Non-compliance notification

BWF Nominees Pty Ltd (BWF) is writing to the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (DPIE), to notify of a non-conformance, in accordance with Condition 5 of Schedule 4 of State Significant Development 6686 (SSD6686).

The non-conformance relates to rock hammering activities that occurred at the Bango Wind Farm project site on Sunday 19th July 2020. Two noise complaints were received in relation to noise impacts associated with construction activities conducted that morning. The non-conformance relates to Condition 6 of Schedule 3 of SSD6686. It also relates to a non-conformance with the *Environmental Planning and Assessment (COVID-19 Development - Construction Work Days) Order 2020,* which restricts rock hammering during the extended hours.

The investigation into this non-conformance is ongoing between BWF and their Contractor. It is expected that the Contractor will finish their investigation into this matter and have information available to BWF 27th July 2020. Following this, BWF will be in a position to provide further advice to DPIE.
