RE: Bango Wind Farm SSD6686 – Condition 5 of Schedule 4 – Non-compliance notification

BWF Nominees Pty Ltd (BWF) is writing to the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (DPIE) to notify of a non-compliance, in accordance with Condition 5 of Schedule 4 of State Significant Development 6686 (SSD6686).

The non-compliance relates to a truck and semi-trailer (a heavy vehicle) accessing the Bango Wind Farm project site via Tangmangaroo Rd on the morning of Saturday 15th August 2020. Condition 24 of Schedule 3 SSD6686 requires that over-dimensional and heavy vehicles access the project site via the transport route identified in the Figure at Appendix 8 (via the Hume Highway and the main project entrance off Lachlan Valley Way).

BWF understands that the non-compliance was identified by site personnel as the truck and semi-trailer was entering the project site. The non-compliance was immediately notified to the Contractor's management representatives and BWF representatives.

The investigation into this non-compliance is ongoing between BWF and their Contractor. It is expected that the Contractor will finish their investigation into this matter and have information available to BWF 24th August 2020. Following this, BWF will be in a position to provide further advice to DPIE.
