Subject: Uungula Wind Farm – Extended use of temporary alternate access route until December 2024

Dear Ms Kidziak

I refer to your request dated 29 May 2024 for the Planning Secretary's approval for an extension to the temporary use of the alternate site access route and additional site access points for pre-construction minor works, in accordance with Condition B28 of Schedule 2 of the development consent for Uungula Wind Farm (SSD-6687).

The Department has carefully reviewed the request and notes that:

- the project is still progressing with detailed design and pre-construction minor works are ongoing;
- there are no changes proposed to the vehicle types and volumes anticipated during the pre-construction phase as detailed in the previous requests regarding use of additional site access points dated 27 October 2021 (SSD-6687-PA-4), 18 January 2023 (SSD-6687-PA-15), 24 November 2023 (SSD-6687-PA-21) and 19 February 2024 (SSD-6687-PA-23); and
- Uungula Wind Farm Pty Ltd has undertaken consultation with Dubbo Regional Council (as the relevant roads authority) and Council has confirmed approval for the continued use of the alternative route and site access points until completion of the pre-construction phase.

Accordingly, the Secretary has approved the extended use of the temporary alternate access routes until 31 December 2024, as follows:

- limited to the number and type of vehicles as outlined in the original request dated 27 October 2021; and
- subject to Uungula Wind Farm Pty Ltd minimising traffic safety impacts of the development (including use of the temporary route) and disruptions to local road users, including minimising potential conflict between development-related traffic and rail services, stock movements and school buses, including preventing queuing on the public road network.
