Subject: Uungula Wind Farm – Traffic Management Plan for non-blade deliveries

Dear Mr Chaplin,

I refer to the Traffic Management Plan updated for the non-blade over-size over-mass (OSOM) deliveries submitted for review and approval in accordance with Schedule 2, Condition B33 of the development consent for Uungula Wind Farm (SSD 6687). I also acknowledge your response to the Department's review comments and request for additional information.

I note the updated Traffic Management Plan has been prepared in consultation with Transport for NSW (TfNSW) and Dubbo Regional Council (DRC) and contains the information required by the conditions of consent.

The Department has carefully reviewed the document and is satisfied that it meets the requirements of the relevant conditions in consent.

Accordingly, as nominee of the Planning Secretary, I approve the Traffic Management Plan (Revision 006D dated 28 March 2026) noting the proponent must submit a letter report, via the Major Projects Portal every two months, detailing progress, and any consultation updates.

The Department notes that an updated Traffic Management Plan for transformer and blade high-risk OSOM movements is to be submitted via the Major Projects Portal for Planning Secretary review and approval. This document is to be prepared in consultation with TfNSW and DRC and capture the route analysis and management prior to commencing deliveries of blade and transformer components on the state road network.
