

G.7.3 Ecology Due Diligence Assessment – Indicative OSOM Haulage Route

Subject: Ecological Due Diligence for OSOM Haulage R	oute

Purpose

This briefing note provides an ecological due diligence assessment which addresses potential biodiversity constraints and impacts at intersection locations along the Over-size/over-mass (OSOM) Haulage Route where intersection upgrades are potentially required, in relation to the Liverpool Range Wind Farm Project.

Outcomes/Key messages

Potential habitat for threatened flora and fauna species within the investigation area is limited, as works are to be conducted within highly disturbed roadside verges. One critically endangered ecological community has been assumed present, and habitat is likely present for four threatened microbat species. Assessments of significance conclude that no significant impact is likely.

Recommendations

Impacts are to be limited to the areas outlined. An ecologist should be present during the clearing and felling of any vegetation.

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Background and Project Understanding

Liverpool Range Wind Farm Pty Ltd (the Proponent), a subsidiary of a portfolio of companies that are trading as Tilt Renewables, is seeking to modify the existing State Significant Development (SSD) approval (SSD 6696) for the Liverpool Range Wind Farm project (the Project). It is located approximately 6 kilometres (km) east of Coolah township, within the Central-West Orana Renewable Energy Zone (REZ), central New South Wales (NSW). This Ecological Due Diligence Assessment has been prepared to assess the potential impacts to native vegetation and habitat associated with localised upgrade works anticipated to be required along the proposed Over-size/over-mass (OSOM) Haulage Route between the Port of Newcastle and the Project site. The OSOM Haulage Route is approximately 250 km in length.

The Project constitutes an approximately \$2 billion investment. State Significant Development Consent (SSD) 6696 (DPIE 2018a) (the Development Consent) was granted by the State Government in March 2018 for the construction, operation, and commissioning of up to 267 wind turbines with a maximum blade tip height of 165 metres above ground level (AGL) and associated infrastructure (Approved Project). In the years since the original Development Consent was determined, there have been significant advances in wind turbine technology, most notably the sector-wide shift towards longer blades and taller towers, allowing more energy to be produced with less turbines.

Since 2019, the Proponent has undertaken a detailed layout review and design optimisation process to firm up the indicative location of infrastructure, understand the extent of associated impacts and required mitigation measures, and to progress the Project towards construction. This process has been informed by recent wind farm construction experience, environmental constraints and updated survey information, and extensive use of 3D terrain modelling.

A modification to the Development Consent is proposed so that the Project can take advantage of these technology changes and provide greater certainty with regards to the constructability of the Project.

1.0 Over-size/over-mass (OSOM) Haulage Route Due Diligence Assessment

The Over-size/over-mass (OSOM) Haulage Route extends approximately 250 km between the Port of Newcastle and the Project site. The OSOM Haulage Route represents the route by which large wind farm components (e.g., wind turbine blades, tower sections, nacelles, and hubs) will be transported to the Project site. Due to the large size of the loads, multiple intersections and road upgrades are likely to be required. GTA Consultants (now Stantec) have produced a series of swept path diagrams that model the movement of the blade haulage vehicle (considered to be the most critical load in terms of ground disturbance and vegetation removal) through constrained intersections and carriageways. The swept path diagrams show the extent of impacts associated with blade swing and required hardstand works to facilitate the movement of the prime mover and dolly trailer.

This due diligence assessment addresses potential biodiversity constraints and impacts at key intersection locations along the OSOM Haulage Route where intersection upgrades are potentially required.

This assessment has identified the potential locations where ground disturbance (hardstands) or tree/shrub removal (blade swing) will potentially occur at each relevant intersection location between Port of Newcastle and the Project site. While the route is extensive geographically, the total area predicted to be disturbed is relatively minor, being 5.1 hectares.

For the purpose of this due diligence assessment, each area has been assessed as being potentially subject to ground disturbing activities to model the worst-case impact scenario to identify potential impacts to threatened species, populations, and ecological communities. In reality, some of the identified impact areas will be subject to blade swing only which will result in no ground disturbance or little to no vegetation clearance. This is a desktop assessment only. No site inspection of each location was conducted.

The majority of the areas potentially impacted by these upgrades are roadside areas that provide no ecological values or habitat and are generally in an already disturbed and degraded condition; most of which already comprise hardstand areas. Importantly, of the 69 locations potentially requiring upgrade, only seven involve potential vegetation removal and/or disturbance, totalling one hectare of habitat removal, of which 0.8 hectares is native vegetation. As such, the purpose of this due diligence assessment is to identify potential ecological constraints and provide ecological assessment of potential impacts and recommendations to mitigate these impacts if required.

The OSOM Haulage Route Investigation Area represents the 69 locations anticipated to require upgrading. The location of the OSOM Haulage Route Investigation Area is shown in **Figures 1.1** to **1.6**

2.0 Methodology

2.1 Database Searches and Literature Review

The database searches for the OSOM Haulage Route Investigation Area included a ten kilometre (km) radius search of the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (DPIE) Atlas of NSW Wildlife Database

(DPIE 2021a) and a one-kilometre radius search under the Commonwealth Department of Agriculture, Water and Environment (DAWE) Protected Matters Search Tool (PMST) (DAWE 2021). A search was conducted around each of the seven locations where vegetation removal is anticipated. This was required to identify those threatened and migratory species, endangered populations, threatened ecological communities (TECs) (or their habitats) that could potentially occur within the OSOM Haulage Route Investigation Area.

Collectively, the Atlas of NSW Wildlife Database searches for the OSOM Haulage Route Investigation Area and the PMST searches identified 47 threatened fauna species, 19 threatened flora species and eight TECs (**Appendix 1**) that could potentially occur.

The most relevant vegetation mapping for the OSOM Haulage Route Investigation Area was the Greater Hunter Vegetation Mapping Version 4.0 (DPIE 2021b). According to this broad-scale regional mapping, the OSOM Haulage Route Investigation Area contains three vegetation communities being:

- 0.4 hectares of *Eucalyptus albens* grassy woodland on basalts of the upper Hunter and Liverpool Plains
- 0.1 hectares of *Eucalyptus blakelyi/ Eucalyptus crebra/ Angophora floribunda* shrubby woodland of the upper Hunter
- 0.4 hectares of Austrostipa aristiglumis/ Aristida ramosa/ Austrodanthonia bipartita grassland on basalt soils of the Merriwa plateau (occurs in conjunction with the *Eucalyptus albens* grassy woodland on basalts of the upper Hunter and Liverpool Plains).
- 0.2 hectares of exotic grassland and planted trees.

The remaining 62 locations consist of mixed exotic and highly disturbed native grassland, and hardstand.

Eucalyptus albens grassy woodland on basalts of the upper Hunter and Liverpool Plains is generally consistent with White Box – Yellow Box – Blakely's Red Gum Grassy Woodlands and Derived Native Grassland listed as critically endangered under both the Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016 (BC Act) and the Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999 (EPBC Act). This critically endangered ecological community (CEEC) is colloquially known as Box-Gum Woodland CEEC.

3.0 Results

Very few biodiversity constraints were identified throughout the OSOM Haulage Route Investigation Area, given its disturbed nature and its proximity to major roadways. **Table 1** provides an outline of each of the seven locations where vegetation disturbance and/or removal is expected to be required.

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Location, Coordinates and Disturbance Type

Coolah Road/Vinegaroy Road, Upper Hunter LGA. Tree Removal.

(773003.93, 6457484.80). Austrostipa aristiglumis/ Aristida ramosa/ Austrodanthonia bipartita grassland on basalt soils of the Merriwa plateau and removal of Box-Gum Woodland CEEC.

Rotherwood **Road/Vinegaroy** Road, Warrumbungle LGA. Tree Removal. (768390.72, 6465804.10). Austrostipa aristiglumis/ Aristida ramosa/ Austrodanthonia *bipartita* grassland on basalt soils of the Merriwa plateau. Potential removal of Box-**Gum Woodland** CEEC.





Minor areas of Box-Gum Woodland CEEC are likely to occur within the OSOM Haulage Route Investigation Area, with 0.4 hectares anticipated to be removed (based on a worst case scenario assessment). While it is considered unlikely that this vegetation would conform to the CEEC under the EPBC Act, due to its very degraded nature and small patch sizes, it has been assumed for the purpose of this assessment that the vegetation does conform, through the application of the precautionary principle. This impact has been assessed by way of Tests of Significance under the *Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016* (BC Act) and the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999* (EPBC Act) which are provided in **Appendix 2** and **Appendix 3** respectively. The Tests of Significance indicate that the anticipated upgrade works along the OSOM Haulage Route are unlikely to constitute a significant impact on threatened species and ecological communities due to the small extent and nature of the anticipated works.

Four threatened micro-bat species were considered to have habitat within the OSOM Haulage Route Investigation Area. A Test of Significance under the BC Act has been completed (**Appendix 2**). No significant impact to these species is anticipated as a result of the anticipated works.

4.0 Conclusions and Recommendations

Potential habitat for threatened flora and fauna species within the OSOM Haulage Route Investigation Area is limited. One critically endangered ecological community has been assumed present, and habitat is likely present for four threatened microbat species. Assessments of significance conclude that no significant impact is likely.

The following general recommendations are provided to assist with the progress of the anticipated upgrade works:

- Wherever practicable, avoid the clearing of hollow bearing trees (HBTs) and areas of Box-Gum Woodland CEEC.
- Disturbance outside of the OSOM Haulage Route Investigation Area must be avoided, as these areas have not been assessed.

- Impacts to creeks and rivers should be avoided as many of these areas along the OSOM Haulage Route are mapped on the DPIE Biodiversity Values Map (2021c), and disturbance to these areas would trigger assessment under the Biodiversity Assessment Method (BAM). This also applies to those areas of native vegetation along Wybong Road outside the anticipated locations identified on Figure 1.
- Prior to construction, clearly mark "no go" zones to avoid inadvertent impacts to the CEEC or important habitat features such as hollow bearing trees (HBTs).
- Should a nest be identified in a tree marked for felling prior to, or during felling works, cease work immediately and consult an environmental advisor.
- A qualified ecologist must be present to supervise the felling of any vegetation.

Threatened Microbat Species

Marginal foraging and *roosting* habitat is likely to occur for four threatened microbat species known to occur in proximity to the OSOM Haulage Route Investigation Area: yellow- bellied sheathtail bat *(Saccolaimus flaviventris),* eastern coastal free- tailed bat *(Micronomus norfolkensis),* eastern false pipistrelle *(Falsistrellus tasmaniensis)* and large bent- winged bat *(Miniopterus orianae oceanensis).* The entirety of the OSOM Haulage Route Investigation Area, being 5.1 hectares in total, has been assumed as suitable foraging habitat for these species, as there is potential for them to forage above both native and exotic vegetation, as well as areas of infrastructure.

Box-Gum Woodland CEEC listed under the EPBC Act is assumed present in the OSOM Haulage Route Investigation Area. It is anticipated that a maximum of 0.4 hectares of this CEEC will be removed as part of the anticipated works. The actual area of impact is anticipated to be much less.

The potential impacts are addressed in detail in the following 'Test of Significance' in accordance with Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999 (EPBC Act).

An action is likely to have a significant impact on a critically endangered or endangered ecological community if there is a real chance or possibility that it will:

reduce the extent of an ecological community

Box-gum woodlands and associated grasslands occur along the western slopes and tablelands of the Great Dividing Range from southern Queensland through NSW to central Victoria. It is suggested that over 95 per cent of box-gum woodlands have been cleared with those remaining representing isolated remnants. The best estimate of the area of occupancy in NSW is 151,100 km² based on 10 x 10 km grid cells (TSSC 2020). While the Commonwealth Listing Advice estimates its national extent to be approximately 416,000 hectares (TSSC 2020).

The Action will impact this community through removal of up to 0.4 hectares of the CEEC, which is negligible when considering is extant area.

The Project has the potential to reduce the extent of the community at a local scale, especially when the CEEC is considerably threatened by further fragmentation, however the amount to be removed is considered negligible and the is considered likely to occur in a highly disturbed condition.

fragment or increase fragmentation of an ecological community

As less than 10 per cent of the original distribution of the CEEC in NSW is likely to have avoided structural changes (TSSC 2020), the CEEC now occurs in a heavily fragmented and isolated form.

In NSW the condition of remnants ranges from woodland, thinned woodland and derived native grasslands; with intact understorey through to weedy understories where only a few hardy natives are left (TSSC 2020). The CEEC occurs with intact overstories or an intact understorey but either may support high conservation value due to the flora and fauna they support (TSSC 2020). Other sites may support important faunal habitat, support threatened species, form part of remaining corridors in the landscape or have the potential for recovery (TSSC 2020). Despite the extent of fragmentation, the conservation value of CEEC occurrences may be independent of remnant size (TSSC 2020).

The Project will impact up to 0.4 hectares. The Project will result in minimal fragmentation of this community as a result of the route upgrades.

Much of the connectivity value of this community in the OSOM Haulage Route Investigation Area has been reduced as a result of historic and current agricultural land use. The Project is unlikely to lead to a substantial increase in fragmentation of this community in the long-term when considering the already disturbed and fragmented landscape, however minor local scale impacts will occur.

adversely affect habitat critical to the survival of an ecological community


An action is likely to have a significant impact on a critically endangered or endangered ecological community if there is a real chance or possibility that it will:

According to the criteria in the Significant Impact Guidelines (DoE 2013) habitat critical to the survival of an ecological community refers to areas that are necessary:

- for the long-term maintenance of the ecological community (including the maintenance of species essential to the survival of the ecological community, such as pollinators)
- to maintain genetic diversity and long term evolutionary development, or
- for the reintroduction of populations or recovery of the ecological community.

Such habitat may be but is not limited to: habitat identified in a recovery plan for the ecological community as habitat critical for that species or ecological community; and/or habitat listed on the Register of Critical Habitat maintained by the minister under the EPBC Act.

The National Recovery Plan (DECCW 2010) identifies that in broad terms habitat that is critical to the survival of box-gum grassy woodland is on the moderate to highly fertile soils of the western slopes of NSW and Queensland, the northern slopes of Victoria, and the tablelands of the Great Dividing Range. All patches of box-gum grassy woodland that meet the minimum condition thresholds should be considered critical to the survival of the CEEC (DECCW 2010). Degraded areas may also be essential to the long-term survival by virtue of their landscape setting (DECCW 2010) because they provide essential ecosystem services for recovery of this community.

It is unlikely that the 0.4 hectares anticipated to be impacted is critical to the CEEC's survival as it is considered unlikely to meet the significant impact guidelines criteria listed above

modify or destroy abiotic factors necessary for an ecological community's survival, including reduction of groundwater levels, or substantial alteration of surface water drainage patterns

While the Project will impact on abiotic factors associated with the CEEC, they are limited to the potential of minor altered surface hydrology during construction, particularly by replacement with hardstand areas which may increase overland surface water flows or sediment movement which could run off into the retained CEEC patches and impact topsoil. Implementation of site-specific mitigation measures during the construction phase would minimise these effects. These impacts are not considered likely to modify or destroy abiotic factors necessary for the survival of the CEEC.

cause substantial change in the species composition of an occurrence of an ecological community, including causing a decline or loss of functionally important species, or

The quality of retained patches of this community has the potential to change due to edge effects such as increased light, wind, altered hydrology and weed invasion. However, given the already disturbed nature of the OSOM Haulage Route Investigation Area due to historic clearing and ongoing grazing pressures, edge effects are unlikely to cause substantial change.

cause a substantial reduction in the quality or integrity of an occurrence of an ecological community, including, but not limited to:

assisting invasive species that are harmful to the listed ecological community to become established, or

causing regular mobilisation of fertilisers, herbicides or other chemicals or pollutants into the ecological community which kill or inhibit the growth of species in the ecological community, or



An action is likely to have a significant impact on a critically endangered or endangered ecological community if there is a real chance or possibility that it will:

As the OSOM Haulage Route Investigation Area already has ongoing disturbances from proximate agricultural land uses, the presence of weeds and grazing have likely resulted in the historic and ongoing use of fertilisers, herbicides or other chemicals or pollutants. It is unlikely that anticipated impacts will cause a substantial reduction in CEEC quality of retained patches. Weeds are likely to invade the adjacent edges of the community. However, under the current land use regime, changes to the quality or integrity of the patch are likely to be negligible.

The Project is not expected to cause a reduction in quality or integrity of the CEEC occurrence recorded through assisting invasive species to become established or causing regular mobilisation of fertilisers.

interfere with the recovery of an ecological community.

The national recovery plan (DECCW 2010) promotes the recovery and prevention of CEEC extinction. It identifies five key objectives:

- 1. Achieving no net loss in extent and condition of the ecological community throughout its geographic distribution
- 2. Increasing protection of sites with high recovery potential
- 3. Increasing landscape functionality of the ecological community through management and restoration of degraded sites
- 4. Increasing transitional areas around remnants and linkages between remnants, and
- 5. Bringing about enduring changes in participating land manager attitudes and behaviours towards environmental protection and sustainable land management practices to increase extent, integrity and function of Box-Gum Grassy Woodland.

The Project will interfere with the recovery of this community through clearing of up to 0.4 hectares, however this impact is considered to be negligible.

Conclusion:

The extent of the community that would potentially be directly impacted comprises a maximum of 0.4 hectares of box-gum grassy woodland CEEC. The actual impacts are likely to be less.

The Project may adversely modify or reduce the composition and quality of retained vegetation through edge effects.

Through consideration of this assessment, the Project will not have a significant impact on the boxgum grassy woodland CEEC.

RE: Desktop Archaeological and Heritage Due Diligence Assessment, Over-size/overmass (OSOM) Haulage Route, Liverpool Range Wind Farm

This letter provides a desktop archaeological due diligence assessment for potential archaeological and heritage constraints and impacts at intersection locations along the Over-size/over-mass (OSOM) Haulage Route where intersection upgrades are potentially required, in relation to the Liverpool Range Wind Farm Project.

This due diligence assessment has been prepared in accordance with the requirements of the *Heritage Act 1977*, the *National Parks and Wildlife Act 1974* and the *Due Diligence Code of Practice for the Protection of Aboriginal Objects in New South Wales* (DECCW 2010) (the Due Diligence Code). This assessment comprises a desktop only assessment.

1.0 Background and Project Understanding

Liverpool Range Wind Farm Pty Ltd (the Proponent), a subsidiary of a portfolio of companies that are trading as Tilt Renewables proposes to construct the Liverpool Range Wind Farm project (the 'Project'), located approximately 6 kilometres (km) east of Coolah township, within the Central-West Orana Renewable Energy Zone (REZ), central New South Wales (NSW). This desktop archaeological due diligence assessment has been prepared to provide advice regarding the potential impacts to Aboriginal and historical heritage associated with localised upgrade works anticipated to be required along the proposed Over-size/over-mass (OSOM) Haulage Route between the Port of Newcastle and the Project site. The OSOM Haulage Route is approximately 250 km in length.

The Project constitutes an approximately \$2 billion investment. State Significant Development Consent (SSD) 6696 (DPIE 2018a) (the Development Consent) was granted by the State Government in March 2018 for the construction, operation, and commissioning of up to 267 wind turbines with a maximum blade tip height of 165 metres above ground level (AGL) and associated infrastructure (Approved Project). In the years since the original Development Consent was determined, there have been Inspired People. Dedicated Team. Quality Outcomes.

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significant advances in wind turbine technology, most notably the sector-wide shift towards longer blades and taller towers, allowing more energy to be produced with less turbines.

Since 2019, the Proponent has undertaken a detailed layout review and design optimisation process to firm up the indicative location of infrastructure, understand the extent of associated impacts and required mitigation measures, and to progress the Project towards construction. This process has been informed by recent wind farm construction experience, environmental constraints and updated survey information, and the extensive use of 3D terrain modelling.

A modification to the Development Consent is proposed so that the Project can take advantage of these technology changes and provide greater certainty with regards to the constructability of the Project.

2.0 Over-size/over-mass (OSOM) Haulage Route Due Diligence Assessment

The Over-size/over-mass (OSOM) Haulage Route extends approximately 250 km between the Port of Newcastle and the Project site. The OSOM Haulage Route represents the route (including all potential alternate routes) by which large wind farm components (e.g., wind turbine blades, tower sections, nacelles, and hubs) will be transported to the Project site. Due to the large size of the loads, multiple intersections and road upgrades are likely to be required. GTA Consultants (now Stantec) have produced a series of swept path diagrams that model the movement of the blade haulage vehicle (considered to be the most critical load in terms of ground disturbance and vegetation removal) through constrained intersections and carriageways. The swept path diagrams show the extent of impacts associated with blade swing and required hardstand works to facilitate the movement of the prime mover and dolly trailer.

This assessment has identified the potential locations where ground disturbance (hardstands) or tree/shrub removal (blade swing) will potentially occur at each relevant intersection location between the Port of Newcastle and the Project site. While the route is extensive geographically, the total area predicted to be disturbed along all potential routes is relatively minor, being 5.1 hectares.

For the purpose of this due diligence assessment, each area has been assessed as being potentially subject to ground disturbing activities to model the worst-case impact scenario to identify potential impacts. In reality, some of the identified impact areas will be subject to blade swing only which will result in no ground disturbance or little to no vegetation clearance. This is a desktop assessment only. No site inspection of each location was conducted.

The OSOM Haulage Route Investigation Area represents the 69 locations along all potential routes that are anticipated to require upgrading. The location of the OSOM Haulage Route Investigation Area is shown on **Figure 1**.

3.0 Methodology

In order to satisfy the relevant requirements, the following methodology has been utilised.

- A review of GIS data providing boundaries for listed items on both relevant Local Environmental Plans (LEPs) and the State Heritage Register (NSW EPI Heritage Layer (DPIE 2019)).
- The completion of searches of the Aboriginal Heritage Information Management System (AHIMS) database. For OSOM Haulage Route works within the Project Site, AHIMS data obtained for the Aboriginal cultural heritage assessment (ACHA Umwelt 2021) was utilised. For other locations, basic searches of the AHIMS database were conducted specific to the OSOM Haulage Route works. Copies of these searches are provided in Attachment 1.
- A review of aerial photography for each of the OSOM Haulage Route works areas with reference to the extent of disturbance (including vegetation clearance).
- For OSOM Haulage Route works within the Project Site, a review of the outcomes of the ACHA (Umwelt 2021) for the Project with reference to the assessment of other proposed road upgrades in the immediate vicinity.

All of this information was used to evaluate whether the proposed OSOM Haulage Route works will, or are likely to, result in impacts to Aboriginal or historical heritage.

4.0 Results

The results of the desktop review of available information are presented in **Table 4.1**.

4.1 Aboriginal Cultural Heritage

As documented in **Table 4.1**, the majority of the OSOM Haulage Route works are at least 500 m from the nearest registered Aboriginal archaeological site, or, in case of works within the Project Site, the nearest area of archaeological potential. The exception to this is Area 4 (Hunter Expressway Crossover), which contains a recorded site within proposed works area. The site is AHIMS 38-4-0822 (Wallis Creek RTA 6) and is listed as a valid site containing stone artefacts. However, this site was partially salvaged during the program of works for the Hunter Expressway, as documented by Umwelt (2018). Based on the description of salvage in the report and the extent of road works, the site is no longer extant with the proposed works footprint. On this basis, there are no extant recorded Aboriginal archaeological sites within the OSOM Haulage Route works areas.

In accordance with the due diligence code, it is also necessary to consider the potential that additional, unrecorded Aboriginal objects may occur. The due diligence code identifies a number of landscape features that indicate the likely existence of Aboriginal objects as including areas within 200 m of waters, where the area does not meet the description of disturbed land. The due diligence code specifies:

'Land is disturbed if it has been the subject of a human activity that has changed the land's surface, being changes that remain clear and observable.'

As described in **Table 4.1**, with the exception of Area 20 (Wybong Road, Muswellbrook) and Area 23 (adjacent to Edderton Road on Saddlers Creek in Muswellbrook), the majority of the OSOM Haulage Route works areas have been wholly modified. In accordance with the provisions of the due diligence code, these modified areas have low archaeological potential.



Area 20 is adjacent to Wybong Road in Muswellbrook and has been partially modified by road construction. However, based on a review of aerial photography, this area includes some mature vegetation and therefore may have been subject to lower levels of disturbance. Similarly, Area 23 on Edderton Road in Muswellbrook has been partially modified by existing road/causeway construction but includes sections of the banks of Saddlers Creek that may be less disturbed. In accordance with the provisions of the due diligence code, a site inspection should be undertaken to clarify the archaeological potential of Areas 20 and 23.

In all other areas, the proposed works areas do not contain any identified Aboriginal objects, do not contain mature trees (based on aerial photography) and have low archaeological potential. Due to the absence of sites and low archaeological potential (including the potential for culturally scarred trees to be present) these areas do not require further assessment.

4.2 Historical heritage

In relation to historical heritage, the majority of the OSOM Haulage Route works are located substantially distant from listed items. As the anticipated works are relatively discrete, associated within existing roads and areas of infrastructure, it is considered unlikely that previously unidentified heritage items will be located in proximity to anticipated works.

The exceptions to this are discussed below.

- Area 1 (George St/Selwyn St, Industrial Drive/Maitland Rd and George St/Industrial Drive intersections) is located within 30 m of the Australian Wire Rope Building (Newcastle LEP I286). The proposed works will not result in direct harm to the listed item. Based on the nature of the proposed works (being establishment of hardstand and inclusion of allowances for blade swing), it is unlikely that they will result in any indirect impact (including visual impact).
- Area 9 (Golden Highway, Jerrys Plains) is within 20 m of the Jerrys Plains Heritage Conservation Area (Muswellbrook LEP C2), a listed area of local significance. The works comprise generalised road works (including establishment of hardstand) within the existing streetscape outside the boundary of the Heritage Conservation Area and will not have a direct or indirect impact.
- Area 6 (Golden Highway/Putty Rd) is within 50 m of the Abbey Green and outbuildings which is identified as being locally significant in the Singleton LEP (listed as I39). The works comprise generalised road works (including establishment of hardstand) within the existing streetscape outside the boundary of the listed item and will not have a direct or indirect impact.
- Area 10 (intersection of the Golden Highway and Denman Rd) is partially within the curtilage of a listed item, being the Merton Cemetery (Muswellbrook LGA I18). This item is listed as being locally significant. There are two portions to this listing, separated by the Golden Highway. The cemetery was associated with the Merton Homestead. Burials occurred at this location from 1825 onwards, initially in the 'original burial ground' and subsequently within the Merton Churchyard. Given that the works will involve ground disturbance within/immediately adjacent to a listed cemetery, a Heritage Impact Statement should be undertaken to determine whether these works may result in impacts to the listed item.
- Area 23 on Edderton Road (at the Saddlers Creek crossing) is within the curtilage of listed item of local significance, being the Edderton Homestead (Muswellbrook LGA 189). Given the location of these works



within a listed item, a Heritage Impact Statement should be undertaken to determine whether these works may result in impacts to the listed item.

In summary, the majority of the OSOM Haulage Route works are unlikely to result in direct or indirect impacts to historical heritage. Further assessment (in the form of a Heritage Impact Statement) is required for the proposed works at the intersection of the Golden Highway and Denman Rd (in relation to the locally listed Merton Cemetery) and at Edderton Road at the Saddlers Creek crossing (in relation to the locally listed Edderton Homestead).

5.0 Management Recommendations

The following recommendations are made with reference to the requirements of the NPW Act, the NPW Regulation, the due diligence code and the Heritage Act. It is noted that these recommendations are provided from an archaeological perspective only.

- All persons working on site that are involved in ground disturbing works should be made aware of their obligations and requirements in relation to the relevant provisions of the NPW Act and the Heritage Act.
- An inspection of Area 20 (Wybong Road, Muswellbrook) and Area 23 (Edderton Road at the Saddlers Creek crossing) should be subject to inspection to clarify the archaeological potential of these areas. The outcomes of the inspection will inform the requirement for any additional approvals to meet the provisions of the NPW Act.
- A Heritage Impact Statement (HIS) is required to evaluate the potential impacts of the proposed works at Area 10 (intersection of the Golden Highway and Denman Rd) in relation to the locally listed Merton Cemetery and at Area 23 (Edderton Road at the Saddlers Creek crossing) in relation to the locally listed Edderton Homestead. The HIS will inform the requirement for any approvals under the Heritage Act.
- The proposed works in all other OSOM Haulage Route works areas may proceed without any further Aboriginal cultural heritage or archaeological investigation, provided that the impacts and extent of the proposed works are consistent with those discussed in this report and outlined in the above recommendations. Works should, however, proceed with caution.
- In the unlikely event that previously unidentified Aboriginal objects or sites are identified whilst carrying out the proposed works, all activities in the immediate vicinity of the identified Aboriginal object should cease and the relevant works supervisor should be advised and should contact a suitably qualified person to assess the objects and provide management advice.
- In the unlikely event that human remains are identified whilst carrying out the proposed works, all activities in the immediate vicinity of the remains should cease. The relevant works supervisor should be advised and will be responsible for contacting the NSW Police to investigate the remains.
