Description of proposal

Construction and operation of a new special education school catering for 200 students in Years K-12 including:

- subdivision of the existing land to create two lots, one to accommodate the proposed Eileen
 O'Connor School and one to accommodate the existing St Peters Catholic College
- demolition of existing structures and hardstand areas
- site preparation and earthworks
- construction of a three storey school building, including:
 - storage and services spaces
 - o learning rooms and other learning spaces
 - o staff rooms and facilities
 - o administration and support spaces
 - a library
 - o multi-purpose hall
- construction of an outdoor learning and play area
- construction of new vehicle access points for entry and exit from Keefers Glen, drop off and pick facilities, an internal service road and at-grade car parking areas
- removal of trees and associated landscaping across the site
- public domain works and upgrades to Keefers Glen.

About the exhibition

An exhibition process allows any individual or organisation to have their say about a proposed development.

The Department of Planning, Housing and Infrastructure (the department) has received a State significant development (SSD) application for the abovementioned proposal.
