Subject: Marulan South Limestone Mine Project Approval SSD 7009 -

Joint Community Consultative Committee

We refer to the recent Approval SSD 7009 for the continued operations of the Marulan South Limestone Mine.

Condition A25 allows......

"With the approval of the Planning Secretary, the Applicant may combine the CCC required by this consent with any similar CCC required by a consent or approval for any adjoining mine or quarry subject to common, shared or related ownership or management."

Likewise, the Approval (06\_0074) for Marulan South Hard Rock Quarry (Peppertree), requires the establishment and operation of a CCC, which has been in place since 2012.

Peppertree's consent condition states that the operation of the CCC "may be fulfilled by the operation of a regional CCC for Boral's mining and quarrying activities in the Marulan area."

It has been agreed by both sites, Marulan Limestone Mine and Peppertree Quarry that a regional CCC would be beneficial. The sites share environmental monitoring equipment and data, reporting on similar environmental performance, and undertake regionally managed community engagement. Our Community engagement footprint covers the same regional areas of Bungonia, Marulan and Tallong.



The process to establish the committee representatives will be undertaken as per the Department's *Community Consultative Committee Guidelines: State Significant Projects* (2019).

We are therefore seeking the Planning Secretary's approval to allow the combination of the CCC and to establish and operate the Boral Marulan South Operations Community Consultative Committee.
