United Wambo Open Cut Mine (SSD 7142) Condition A16

We refer to condition A16 in Part B of Schedule 2 of development consent SSD 7142 for the United Wambo Open Cut Coal Mine (United Wambo). Condition A16 contains the following requirement.

Within 12 months of commencement of development under this consent, or other timeframe agreed by the Planning Secretary, the Applicant must surrender the existing development consent for United Underground Coal Mine (DA 410-11-2002-i) in accordance with the EP&A Regulation.

Note: This requirement does not extend to the surrender of construction and occupation certificates for existing and proposed building works under the former Part 4A of the EP&A Act or Part 6 of the EP&A Act as applies from 1 September 2018. The surrender should not be understood as implying that works legally constructed under a valid consent or approval can no longer be legally maintained or used.

United Wambo request an extension to the timeframe of A16 from within 12 months of commencement of development being up to 6 January 2021 to 25 February 2021. This date is consistent with the date the Independent Environmental Audit (IEA) required under Condition E12 is required to be submitted as per Condition E13, i.e. within 3 months of commencement of the IEA, which commenced on 25 November 2020.

This extension will allow the IEA to assess and close out all conditions of DA 410-11-2002-I as part of the Audit Report in accordance with the EP&A Regulation.
