**United Wambo Coal Mine (SSD-7142)  
Condition B82 extension request**

I refer to your request (SSD-7142-PA-60) for an extension of time to finalise the archival recording, salvage, reconstruction and public display of the Dog-leg fence as required under the condition B82(d) of Schedule 2 of **SSD-7142**.

The Department notes that the above works are to be completed within 2 years of commencement of development under SSD-7142, and that development under SSD-7142 commenced on 6 January 2020. Further, that while considerable progress has been made towards finalising the required works, due to unforeseen delays it is unlikely that the works will be completed by 6 January 2022.

I can advise that the 2-year time frame is an explicit requirement of the condition. Accordingly, the Secretary requests that you undertake all endeavours to complete the requirements of condition B82(d) of Schedule 2 of SSD-7142 as soon as practicable.
