Picnic/Play Areas

Sydney Zoo is a place to enjoy a relaxing and fun day out. Picnic and play areas are integral to the design of the park. They have been strategically placed at points within the zoo to provide people with places to relax and have a meal within the vicinity of animals.

Visitors to will be welcome to bring their own food and drinks into the zoo or choose to patronise one of the kiosks within the picnic areas or the restaurant. The aim is to provide a memorable and affordable experience. Some picnic areas will provide toilet and baby change facilities.

Large fig trees will be a feature of these spaces to provide shade and amenity. Simple shade canopies will also be used to provide more shade where needed.

Simple, natural play elements will entertain children and young people while adults are able to relax on a generous lawn.

Each of the 4 picnic areas will have a relationship with one or more animal exhibits. This will create the opportunity to eat lunch and play while simultaneously watching animals, creating a unique experience.
