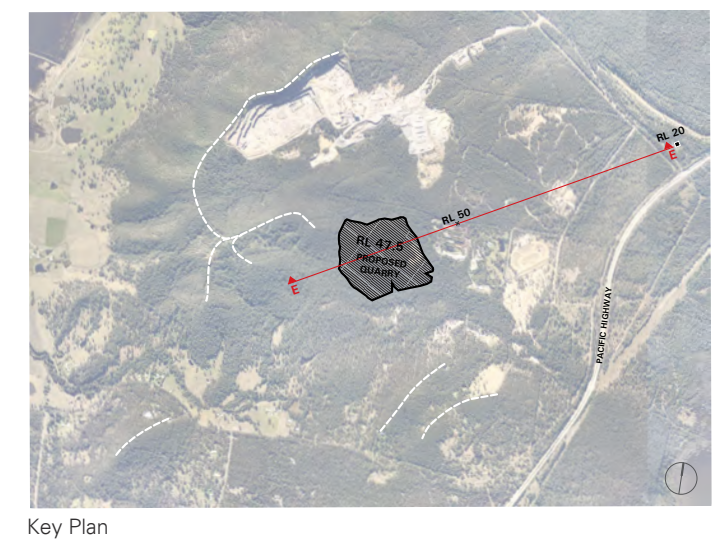
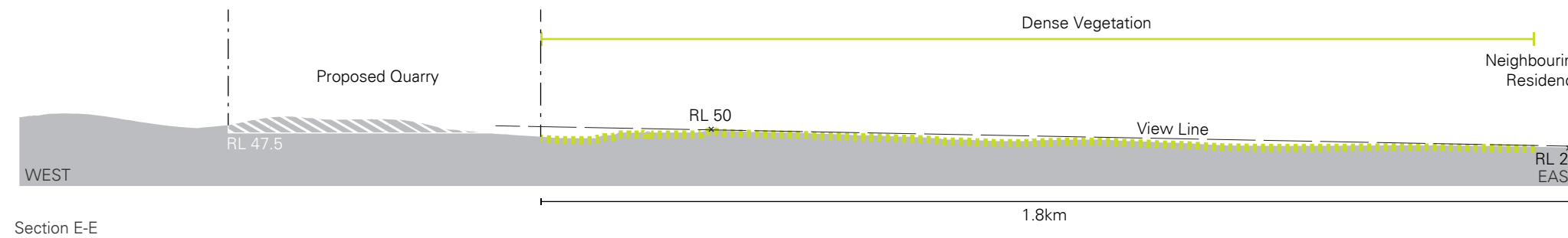
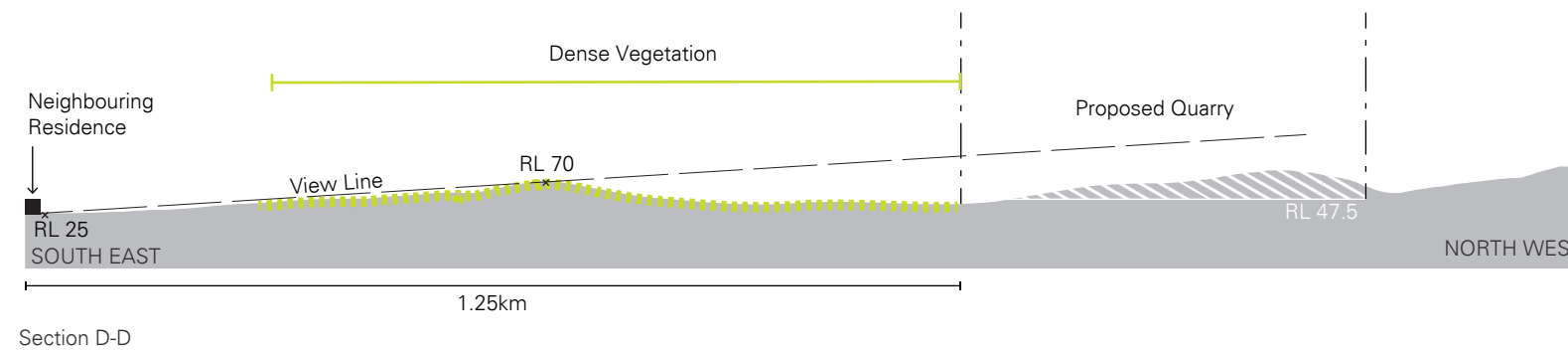




Conclusions

- Dense wooded vegetation covers the slopes of the site and the greater hills area.
- Near views to the site are masked by foreground ridgelines and dense vegetation
- From the north, east and south the hills are almost entirely obscured by tall and dense tree stands that line the rural roads, are abundant within the rural properties and provide significant cover along the slopes in the hills.
- The most important views to the hills are from the west. These views provide a green backdrop to the visual catchment and should be significantly maintained.
- Prominent views from the west should not be greatly impacted due to the location of the quarry behind foreground ridges and dense vegetation.
