

Dear Resident,

This is an update relating to the UTS Central Project located on Broadway at the intersection of Jones Street, Ultimo. In particular, we'd like to highlight the installation of the second tower crane, which is planned for the end of June. We would also like to inform you of planned out of hours (night works) for Sunday, 9 July to relocate an existing light pole on Broadway. The light pole is currently obstructing the newly created vehicle access way and will be moved a few metres west of its location. The vehicle entry from Broadway is expected to be operational by Friday, 14 July following installation of pedestrian management controls.

### Progress to date

Construction of the new structural elements is progressing, with several concrete pours to the lift core now complete. Strengthening of existing columns has taken place, infill slabs around columns formed, and additional new columns and footings also poured.

### Upcoming milestones

- 29 June – 1 July 2017: erection of the second tower crane (weather permitting)
- 9 July 2017: relocation of existing City of Sydney Smart Pole (light pole)

### What to expect

In a similar way to when the first crane was installed back in March, a mobile crane will be established within the Jones Street construction zone, which will be used to lift the tower sections into place. The remainder of the install will be completed by the existing tower crane. Council permits are in place to work outside of approved hours (until 8pm). Should adverse weather conditions delay the planned install, it will be postponed until the following week (Thursday, 6 July – Saturday, 8 July).

Partial closure of the bus lane along Broadway will be needed in order to facilitate the light pole relocation. Traffic management controls will be in place throughout the works, which are expected to be undertaken between 8pm and 5am. Following decommissioning of the light pole, a truck mounted crane will be used to move it to its new location. New cable runs will be installed and the light pole commissioned upon completion.

A level of noise is to be expected during these works and we thank you for your patience.
