**Sandstone Precinct – Education Building Stage 2 SSD-7484 – Condition B7 Design Modifications – Education Building**

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Thank you for your email on 12 November 2020 inviting comments from the Heritage Council of NSW on the above State Significant Development Condition B7 prior to its submission to the Secretary:

*The design development for the Education Building is to ensure that the curved glass corners remain and are not modified to a faceted form. Prototypes are to be constructed in consultation with Council and the Heritage Council and submitted for approval by the Secretary prior to issue of Construction Certificate 6 - Facade and Finishes (CC6).*

As Delegate of the Heritage Council, I have reviewed following information:

- Architect (Webber) GA plans for level 06, 07 and 08 showing extent/locations of the curved glass (new façade).
- Shop drawings from Façade contractor (JML) showing curved glass assembly
- VMU summary report with photos showing curved FT03 (courtyard) and FT08 (upper levels new façade).

From the information provided HSNW officers are satisfied that curved glass corners are consistent with the objectives of Condition B7, are consistent with the endorsed CMP for the Education Building prepared by GBA Heritage (May 2017) and are consistent with the design revisions approved through Stage 2 SSD 7484 Mod 10.
