Following the meeting yesterday, we have undertaken some preliminary investigations into the requirement for and the feasibility of a left turn deceleration lane into the proposed new access at Hunter Sports High School.

It has been identified that there are numerous constraints at this location, and as the development does not include any increase in student or staff numbers, a formal deceleration will not be required. Roads and Maritime considers that the removal of parking on approach to the proposed driveway (that is designed with appropriate splays and width) will be sufficient to ensure the safety and efficiency of the Pacific Highway is not compromised. The amount of parking to be removed will be subject to further investigation.
