RE: Request for Advice on SEARs – SSD-76610458 –Devlins Bridge Wind Farm

Thank you for your request for advice from the NSW Environment Protection Authority (EPA) on the Department of Planning, Housing and Infrastructure's draft Secretary's Environmental Assessment Requirements (SEARs) for the proposed Devlins Bridge Wind Farm, to be located approximately 22km west of Narrandera and 17km south-west of Leeton, immediately south of the Sturt Highway within the Local Government Area of Narrandera (SSD-76610458).

The EPA notes that the proposal consist of:

- The construction, operation and decommissioning of a wind farm with an estimated capacity of 680 megawatts (MW), up to 94 turbines with a maximum height of 290 metres (to blade tip); and
- Ancillary infrastructure including one primary terminal station and one collector substation, underground and overhead cabling, meteorological monitoring masts, operational maintenance facility, access tracks, construction compound, and grid connection to the transmission network.

In view of the information provided, the EPA advise that the draft SEARs appear to be adequate, and we have no further comment to provide.
