Temora Shire Council has reviewed the draft SEARs and scoping report and we are satisfied with the items identified.

Council accepts the level of investigation in the scoping report and agree with the draft SEARs proposed.

However there are some additional matters Council would like addressed which include:

- an air quality investigation of the operations at GrainCorp during harvest and confirmation that levels of dust generated do not cause an impact upon the future operation of the BESS. This would be to ensure that there are no future demands to limit the amount of grain deliveries or for GrainCorp to install additional dust management or air quality monitoring equipment (above existing environmental requirements), due to dust/emissions generated being incompatible with the operations of the BESS (sensitivity to dust generation, truck exhaust emissions) **or alternatively**, information is provided by the applicant to demonstrate that this is not an issue to operations of the BESS (not affected by dust or truck emissions during operations, due to for example design, setback, vegetation screening).
- Fire Management plan. The applicant should outline the precautions/mitigation measures available to ensure that any outbreak of fire can be contained/compartimentalised and not threaten or impact surrounding properties or the localities/towns electricity supply network.
