

# CHAU CHAK WING MUSEUM



The Chau Chak Wing Museum will, for the first time, allow the co-location of the University of Sydney's unique collections to create a new world class cultural destination and a new heart for the University's Cultural Precinct.

The Chau Chak Wing Museum is located on one of the last remaining greenfield sites within the University of Sydney's Camperdown Campus that can accommodate a major new free standing building.

Together with the Fisher Library to the south, the Chau Chak Wing Museum frames vistas to and from The Quadrangle and forms a new gateway to the Campus.

Directly opposite the Great Hall, the Chau Chak Wing Museum is set within a significant landscape of mature trees, with views to the east of the city skyline and Victoria Park.
