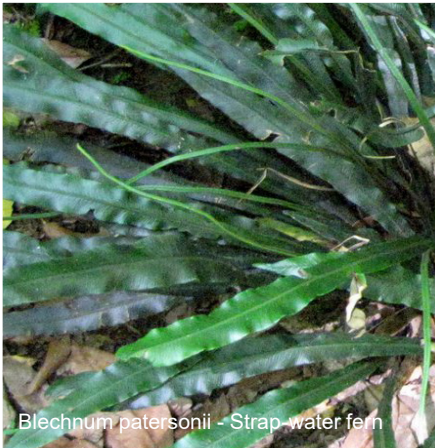

DESIGN CONSIDERATIONS

The fern garden will include a mix of ferns that have already been planted at Barangaroo Reserve. The delicate foliage will contrast well with the surrounding porphyry paving and the varied rich greens will contrast well with the natural sandstone “veins”.

DESIGN CONSIDERATIONS

Star Jasmine will be planted at the base of the signature fig trees at each of the raised planter locations. Star jasmine is tolerant of shade and will ensure that clear views are permitted under the fig tree canopies. Frgrant white flowers will be produced in summer.
