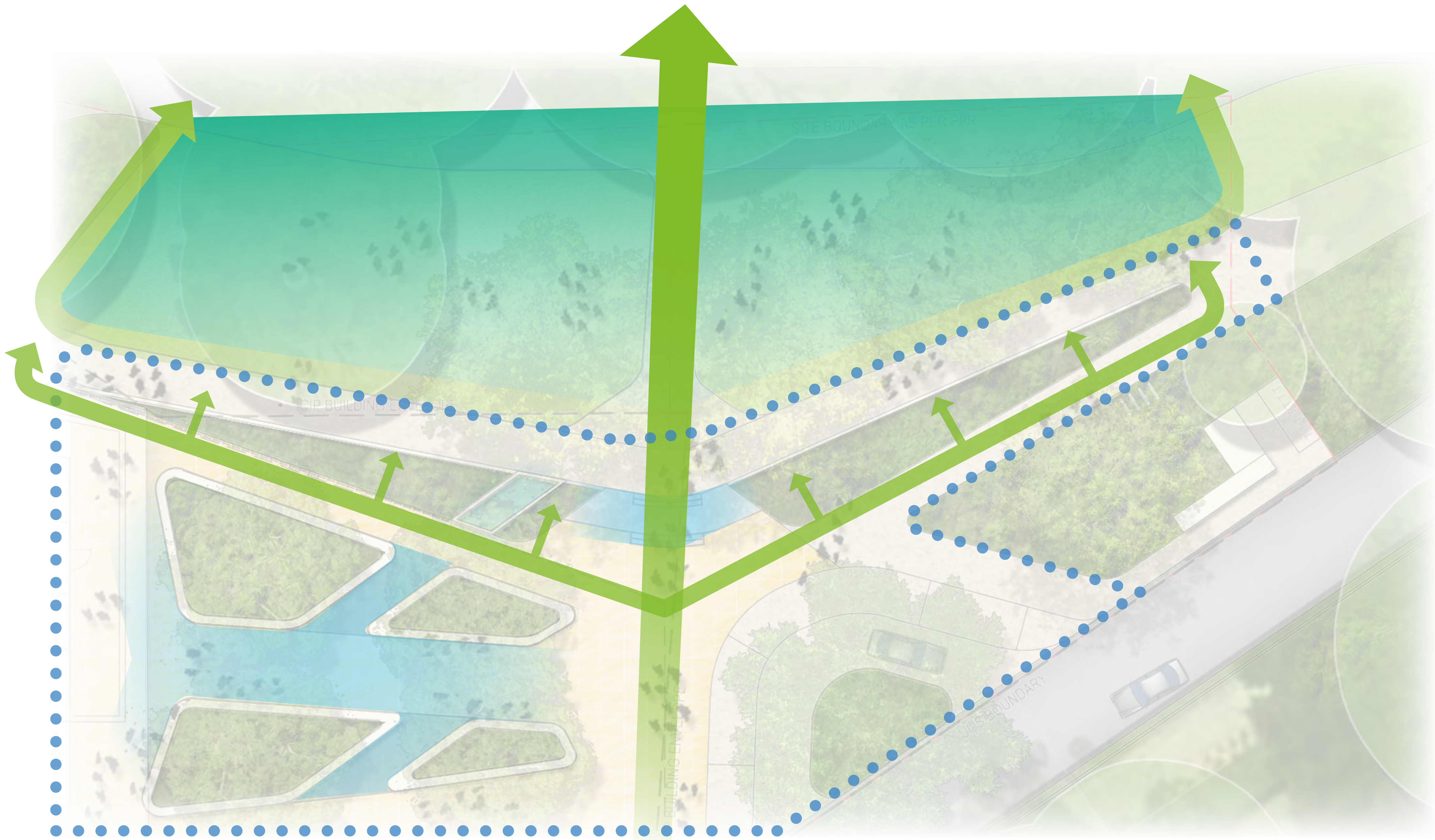


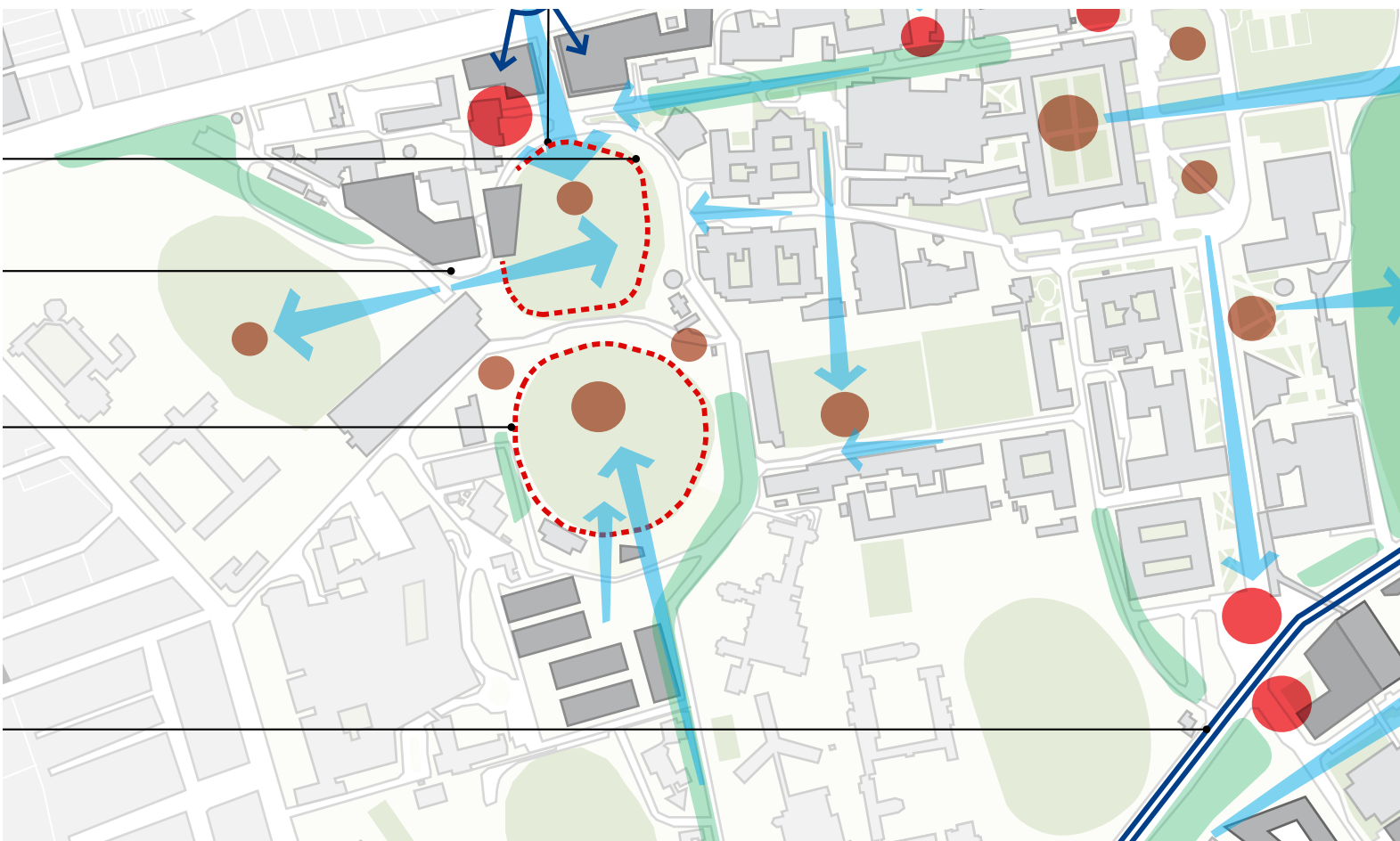
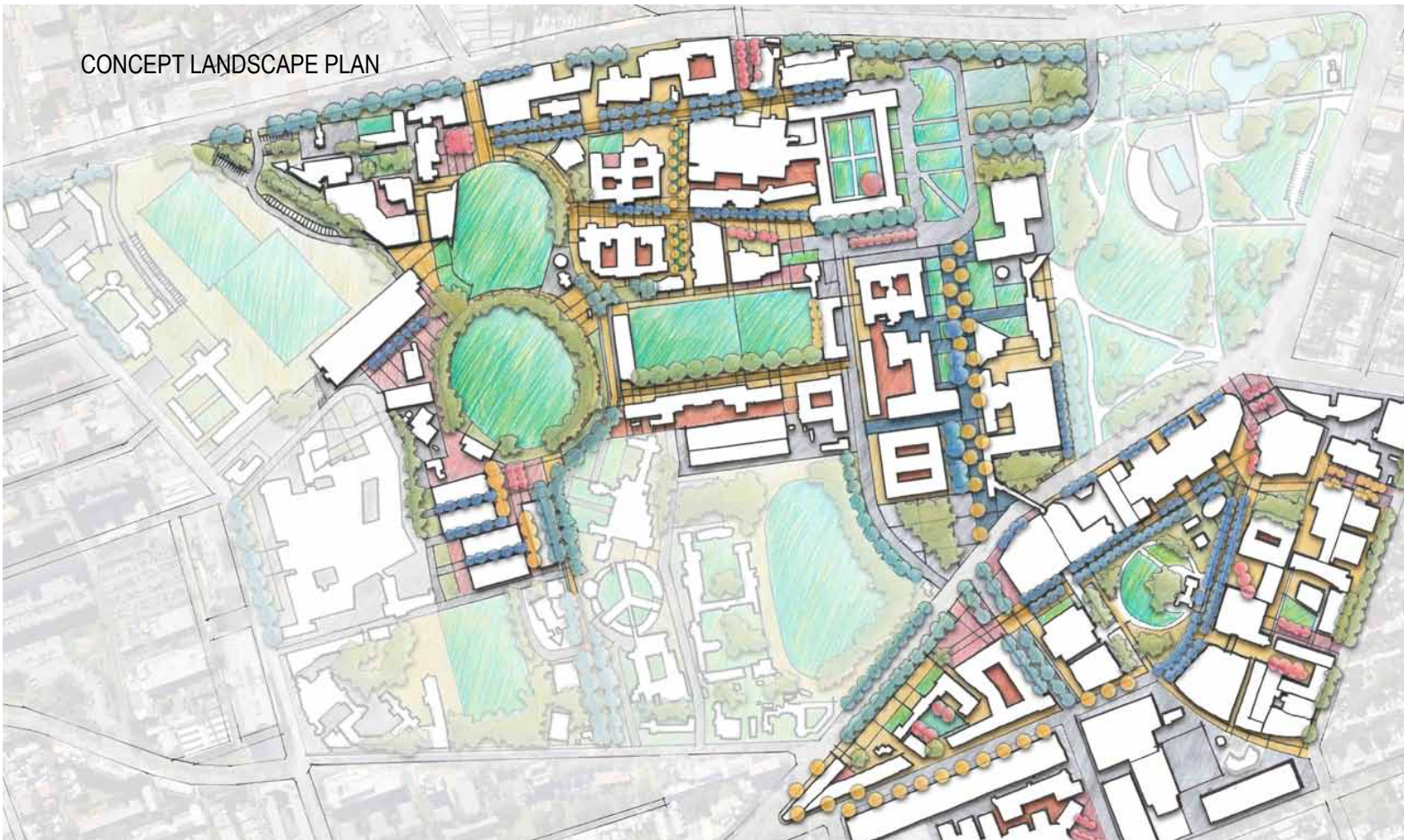

-  Maximise visual and physical connections to green spaces

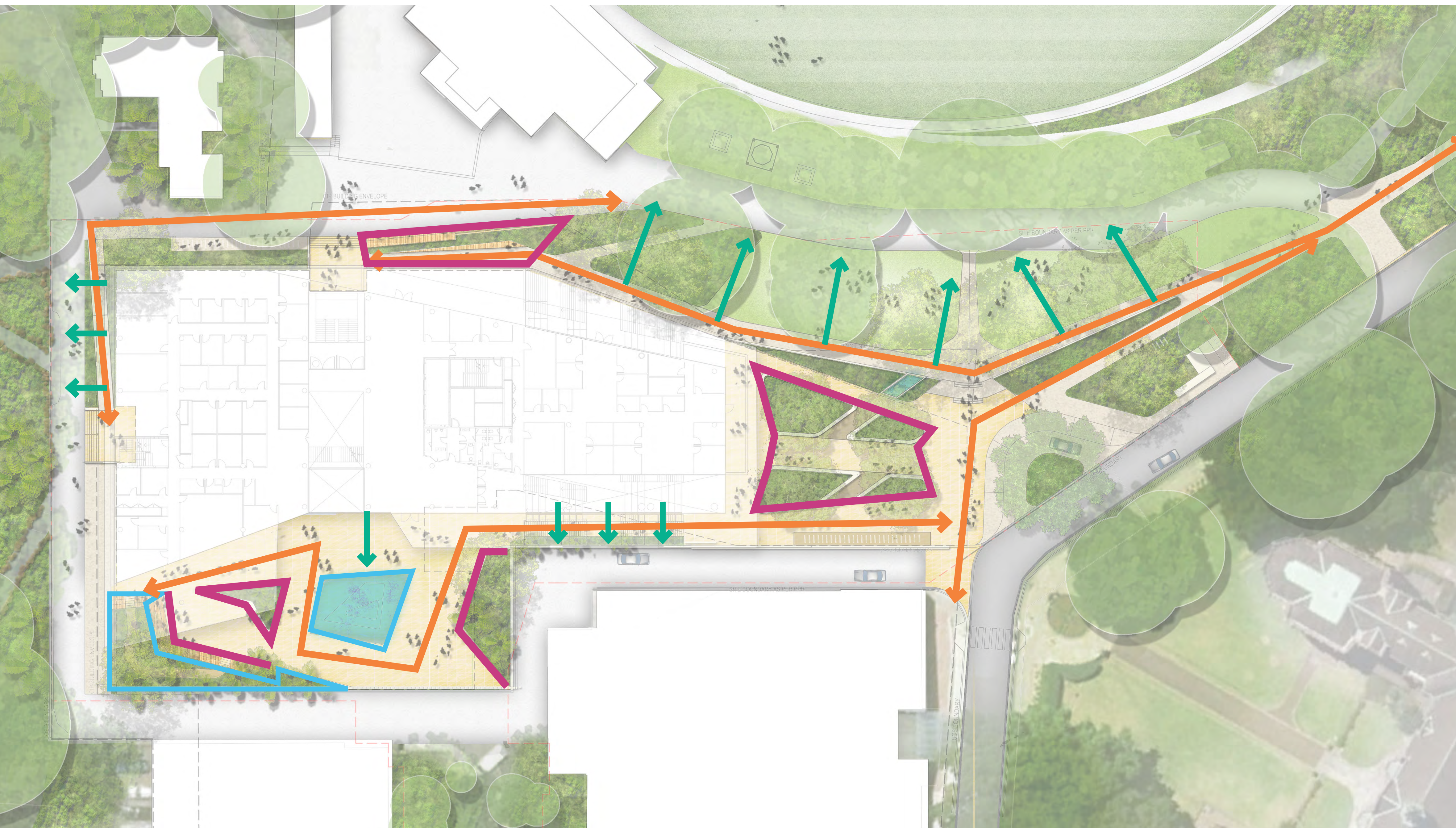

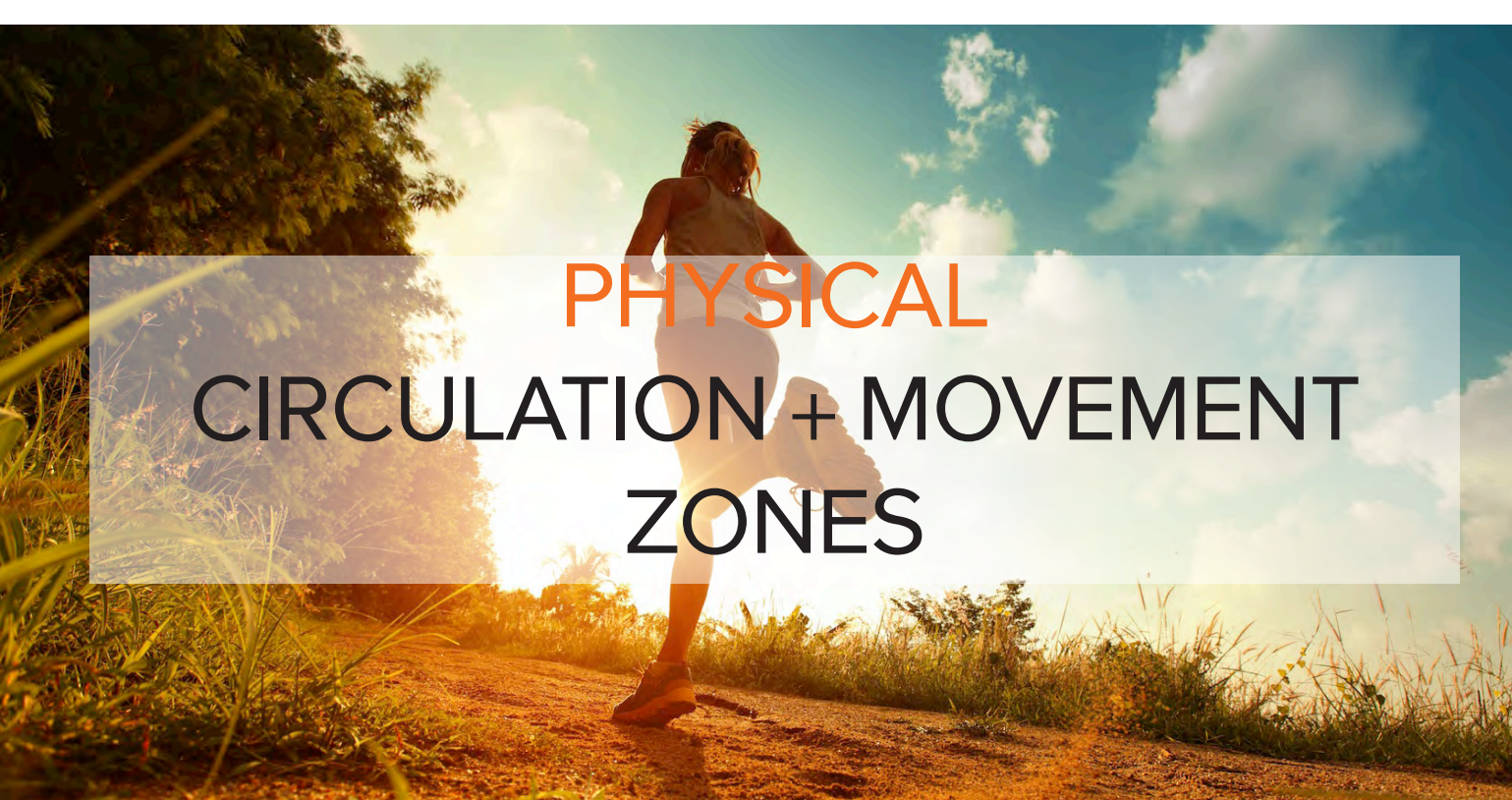

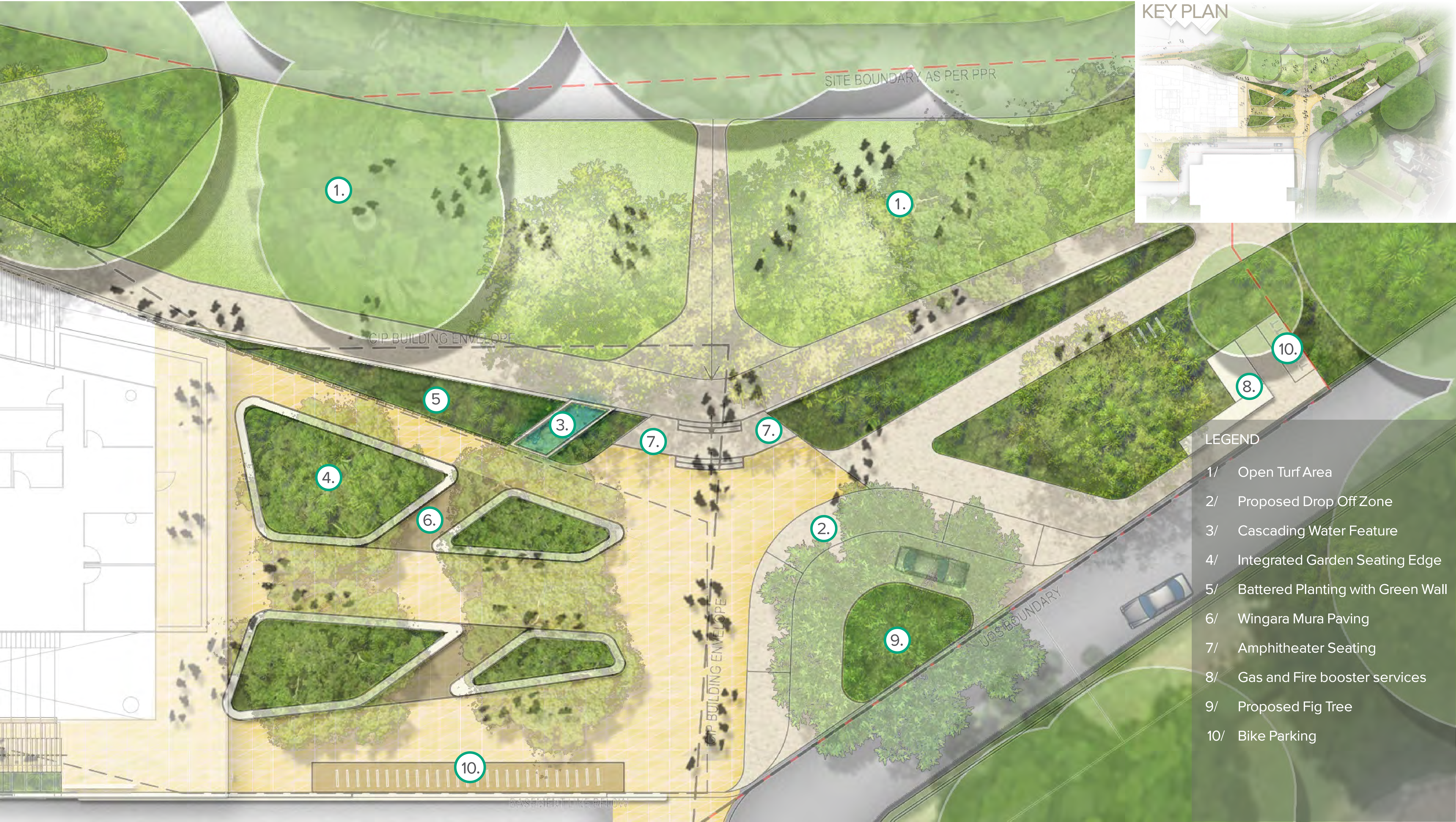


LANDSCAPES THAT HEAL
