

5.2 PLANTING DESIGN_PLANTING CHARACTER



This planting strategy aims to strengthen the indigenous vegetation of the local area to create an Urban Bushland character. By reintroducing lost vegetation communities such as the Sydney Turpentine Ironbark Forest, the site can enhance a sense of scenic heritage through the distinctive characteristics found in bush habitat of colour, smell and texture which give the site a uniquely Australian quality.

Urban Bushland also plays a role in supporting wildlife corridors, allowing migrating local fauna to 'filter through' large cities and urban environments. By employing an Urban Bushland approach, the site will not only enhance the character and culture of the area, but also serve as a site of shelter and food for local fauna.

A large proponent to the planting strategy is the underlying theme that landscapes heal, key species have been chosen for their underlying healing and medicinal elements.
