Question	Response
How much litter do they require for a commercial-scale operation at the finished level?	Approximately 40,000 tonnes per year
Do they have concrete floors in them?	No. On the coast nobody does concrete floors
Every single one has done them – all Baiada. It's a Baiada requirement. It's also a highly reactive ground issue – the area ends up with 60 -70mm cracking. Therefore, prophetic material shoots out of the cracks.	If that is what we are required to do, then we will concrete the floors.
Obviously it is different ground on the coast, not so Geotechnically reactive?	We have highly reactive ground. From a DPI point-of-view they have done a lot of work in assessing whether or not nutrient travels through the soils – they have not found anything this includes the Baiada sheds.
Up here you have to have concrete floors.	All farms will have concrete floors.
