- rationalization of the roof plant to a more compact arrangement makes a lot of sense and claws back a bit of the skyline view
- the layered and louvered screen design also looks to offer a sensible approach to addressing the visual impact of the plant
- further reflective glare off the ducting looks like it will be pretty well blocked by the inverted louver arrangement. I'm guessing that the screen itself will be some sort of powder coated aluminum to reduce reflective glare off the screen itself? Can you please clarify.
