Dear Angus,

I refer to the West Sydney Stadium development and the stage 2 submission responses from the Authority relating to Equity of Access (item 12).

Revise the design to demonstrate compliance with SEARs No. 4 and Guidelines relating to equity of access: Before Compliance will work with the project Architect and Landscape designer to ensure the project will achieve compliant with the SEARS's No. 4 Guild lines with a design that achieves compliance via Deemed to Satisfy design and where applicable via Performance Based Solutions.

The Southern and Western Car parks should include accessible car parking spaces with associated equitable access paths of travel:

Before Compliance will work with the project Architect and Landscape designer to ensure that accessible carparking is provided to the Southern and Western carparks or otherwise to ensure that wayfinding signage is provided to direct to the accessible carparking bays and that the accessible carparking provided is located near the entrances to the building, it is considered that as long as the location and ratio is met then the requirements of Clause D3.5 is satisfied.

The design should include integrated ramps that offer equally celebratory access between the lower public domain and the upper exterior stadium podium.

Lift access is provided to the South East of the allotment as the level difference is too great to provide ramped access within the maximum permitted 3.6m rise allowable under BCA/NCC Clause D3.11, the North East and North West provides at grade access to the concourse. Compliant access will be provided to and within the building meeting the requirements of DAPS, BCA/NCC and Australian Standards and will be confirmed during design development.
