**Subject:** Threatened Species Licence to remove one Grey Ironbark

I refer to your application to the Department of Climate Change, Energy, the Environment and Water received on 19 February 2025 for a Threatened Species Licence, a class of biodiversity conservation licence under Part 2 of the *Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016 (BC Act)*, to pick and damage the habitat of a critically endangered ecological community (CEEC), including by removing one Grey Ironbark (*Eucalyptus paniculata*) from your property at 55 Werona Ave Gordon. This tree forms part of the Sydney Turpentine-Ironbark Forest CEEC.

The Department understands that Ku-ring-gai Council's Tree Management Officer has confirmed that this tree is a risk to life/property. The Department also understands approval from Council is not required for removal of the tree.

I have assessed your licence application in accordance with the provisions of the BC Act and the *Biodiversity Conservation Regulation 2017* and I have decided to grant a biodiversity conservation licence for this action.

A copy of your new biodiversity conservation licence is enclosed. Please note that your licence is subject to conditions. These conditions are outlined in the licence. It is an offence under s2.14(4) of the BC Act to breach a condition of a licence.

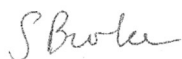
Pursuant to sections 2.11 and 2.13 of the *Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016*, I hereby authorise the following action to be undertaken:
