Community Notification – Expansion to Operations

Dear Resident,

Bulk Recovery Solution (BRS) is proposing to amend its current operations at 16 Kerr Road, Ingleburn and wish to notify you of these changes. Refer to Figure 1 for site location.

Currently BRS recycle and process liquid waste and construction and demolition waste including concrete, concrete washout water, stormwater and soils. The facility provides a sustainable and environmentally friendly method for waste resource recovery.

It is proposed to expand the current operations to:

- Process liquid waste including oily water, sewer silt and debris and grease;
- Increase the annual processing and storage capacity of waste materials; and
- Expand hours of operation to 24 hours, 7 days per week for certain operations.

An environmental impact assessment (EIS) is being prepared to identify and assess likely environmental impact associated with the proposed expansion. The EIS will be submitted and assessed by the NSW Department of Planning and Environment.

BRS has engaged an environmental consultant to prepare the EIS who are undertaking a number of specialist assessments including air quality, noise and traffic. In relation to these specialist assessments preliminary investigations indicate the following:

- Noise - It is expected that there will be no change to noise levels at residential premises given the type of equipment, location within the building and operational procedures;
- Air – it is expected that there will be no additional air quality impact given the majority of operations are located within the building, water sprays to suppress dust will be used and closed handling systems employed; and
- Traffic – there will be an increase in traffic movements. Heavy vehicles will access the facility via Henderson Road and Williamson Road to the Hume Highway thereby limiting traffic impacts through residential areas.
