Hi Luke

After further confirmation from Mark, please see attached the revised tree schedule, available in 200Lt or 400Lt.

As previously mentioned, we have accepted the following alternative tree species to be approached by City of Sydney, in order to achieve the minimum 200Lt requirement.

- *Archontophoenix alexandrae* Alexander Palm 200lt, in place of *Archontophoenix cunninghamiana* (which only available in 100lt)
- *Waterhousea floribunda* 'Green Avenue' 200lt, in place of *Syzygium luehmannii* (which only available in 100lt)

Both substituted species have the same character and appearance as the original nominated species, and are in the City of Sydney / University of Sydney tree list.
