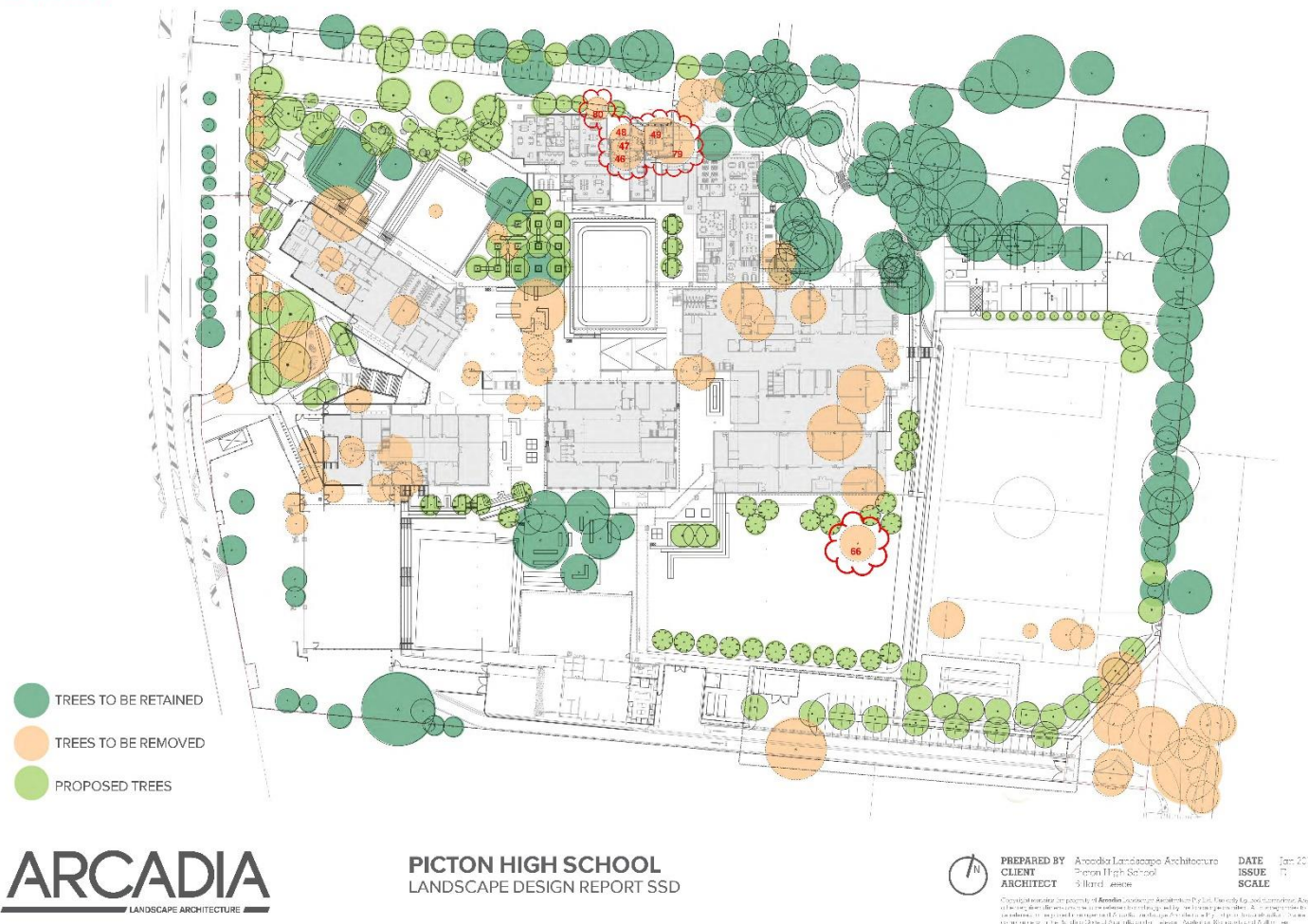


Figure 1: Tree retention and removal plan.
