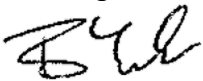
Thank you for your recent approval of the revised Biodiversity Offset Management Plan and Strategy (BOMPS) required under SSD8642 Schedule 2 Condition B53 and B57 dated 23 December 2025. Mangoola notes that the approval triggers a review of the Conservation Bond, and if required, an updated bond is required to be lodged within 3 months in accordance with Condition B62 due 23 March 2026. Further, Mangoola notes that Condition B61 requires the calculation of the Conservation Bond to be submitted to the Department for approval at least 2 months prior to the lodgement of the bond due 23 January 2026.

Due to a period of leave over Christmas and New Year for both Mangoola staff and the endorsed experts responsible for the revision of the BOMPS and Conservation Bond, Mangoola is requesting an extension of time to submit the revised calculation for approval.

Lily Gorrell and Janene Devereux were endorsed as suitably qualified and experienced for the purposes of revising the BOMPS on 10 July 2025. Mangoola engaged them to undertake the Conservation Bond review and the BOMPS revision. Lily and Janene have not yet returned from Christmas leave. Please consider granting an extension of time to submit the revised calculation to 6 February 2026.
