



FEATURE PARKLAND TREES
up to 30m tall and 10m wide
These trees will be used as solitary trees in a brader garden bed area, so that their broad canopy spread can be appreciated.

AVENUE TREES
15 - 30m tall & 8 - 10m wide
Avenue trees will be selected for their reliable growth characteristics able to provide substantial avenues enabling much needed shade to key pedestrian routes.

CARPARK TREES
10 - 20m tall & 5m wide
Carpark trees will be selected for their ability to withstand compaction and perform reliably providing shade canopies over carpark areas.

STREET TREES
15 - 30m tall & 8 - 10m wide street trees will be selected for their reliable growth in street environment.

OPEN SPACES & OUTDOOR AREAS VEGETATION
A mix of locally native and feature trees and shrubs suitable for each location.

NATIVE PARKLAND TREES AND NATIVE GRASS UNDERSTOREY
A locally native trees and understorey species complimenting existing bushland remnants.
