Dear Scott

The proponents RTS for major alterations and additions to the Stevenson Library Building at The Scots College, 29-53 Victoria Road, Bellevue Hill (SSD 8922) agrees to the following two conditions relating to Aboriginal cultural heritage as per OEH letter dated 13 September, 2018. As such please ensure these conditions extracted below are conditioned on any forthcoming consent.

“In accordance with the recommendations outlined in Clause 14.3 – Historical Archaeological Assessment in the Environmental Impact Statement prepared by BBC Consulting Planners dated July 2018, OEH recommends that the following archaeological management be included in any development consent that may be issued for the site:

- Prior to onsite ground disturbance commencing, the designated project team including all contractors on site should undergo heritage induction, which will include an archaeological awareness component to reinforce the importance of heritage issues and the management measures that will be implemented.
- In the event of an unexpected discovery of archaeological relics during ground disturbance works the Unexpected Find Procedure should be followed. The procedure details the actions to be taken when a previously unidentified and/or potential Aboriginal and/or historical heritage item/object/site is found during construction activities.”
