Re: SSD 9031 Avonlie Solar Farm – Request for temporary increase to vehicle length under CoA 2 (b)

Iberdrola refers to:

1. SSD 9031 Avonlie Solar Farm, which was approved by the Executive Director, Energy and Resources, as a delegate of the Minister for Planning on 8 August 2019;
2. Approval of Traffic Management Plan and Heavy Vehicle Restrictions (SSD-9031-PA-23);
3. Approval of Temporary Amendment to Heavy Vehicle Restrictions (SSD-9031-PA-27); and
4. Approval of Temporary Amendment to Heavy Vehicle Restrictions (SSD-9031-PA-33);

Iberdrola is seeking approval for the following temporary increase to the maximum length of vehicles under Schedule 3 CoA 2 (b):

- a. Starting date: 24 May 2023 (or such later date as approved by the Department);
- b. Duration: 14 days from approval; and
- c. Increase request: 4 vehicles/day, length of vehicles used for the development (excluding over-dimensional vehicles) to increase from 19 m to 26 m for above duration;

Note the total number of heavy vehicle movements per day will remain unchanged.

This application represents a reduction from the limits approved in the previous modifications. The difference between previous approvals and this application is shown below:

The purpose for increase is to allow safe demobilisation of the portable buildings that were used during construction, and also help reduce the number of traffic required to complete site demobilisation.
