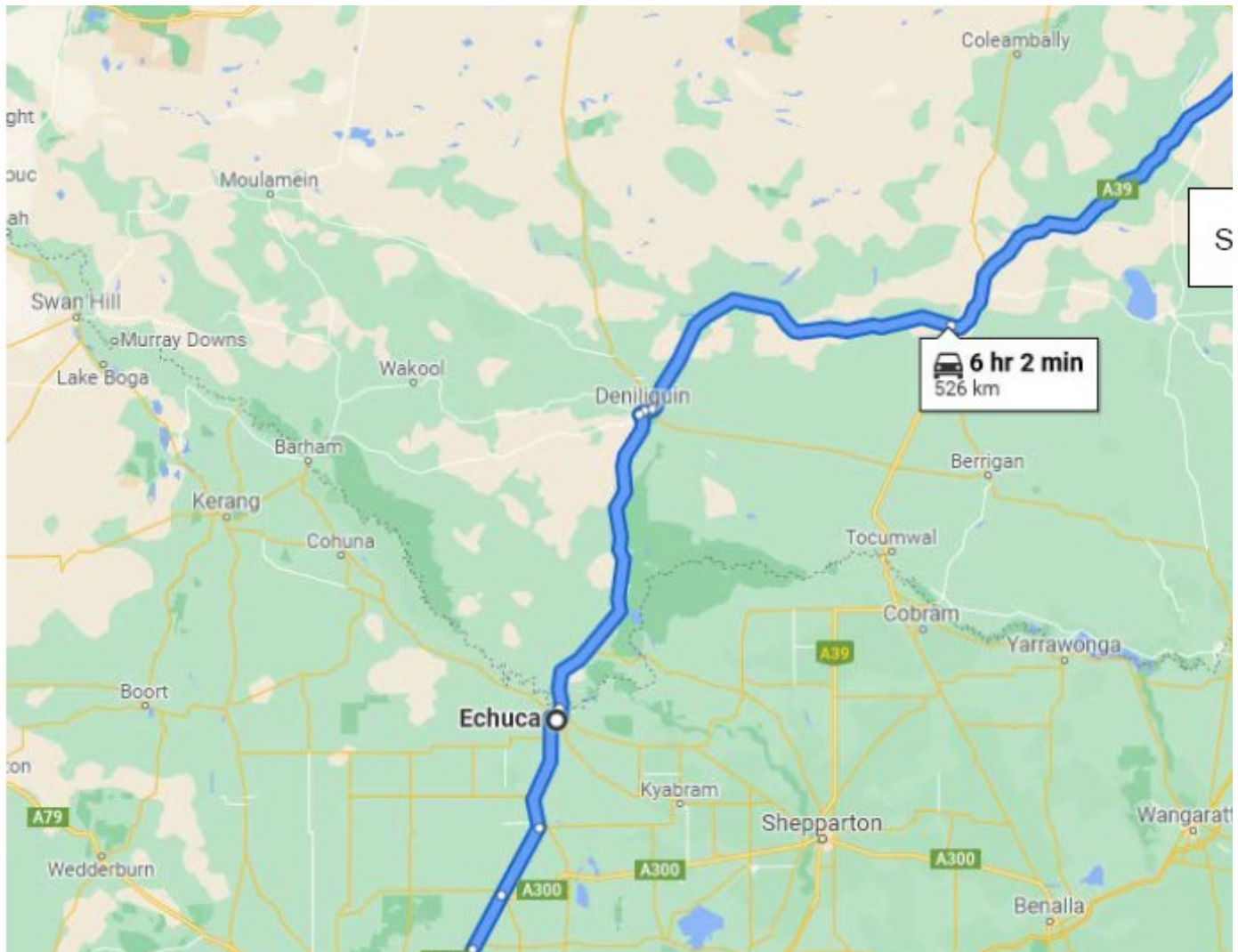

Hi Maurice,

I would like to consult with TfNSW regarding the following temporary increase of vehicle length for Avonlie solar farm:

- Duration: 14 days.
- Starting date: 22 May 2023 or later date as approved by DPIE.
- Increase request: 4 vehicles/day, maximum length increase from 19m to 26m.
- Total number of heavy vehicles per day: remains unchanged. The site currently receives less than 5 trucks a day.

This request is to allow for safe demobilisation of the portable buildings that were used during construction. There have been three similar approvals from DPIE in the past with the most recent one expired on 31 January 2023.

Please kindly let me know if any further information is required.
