Revised Community Communication Strategy, Conditions A29 and C7

Dear Recep

I refer to your revised Community Communication Strategy (CCS) submitted to the Planning Secretary under condition A29 of SSD-9227.

I note the revised CCS:

- was reviewed by the Applicant, and no issues were raised to the Department;
- has been updated to include the scope of work for Stage 2 as per condition C7(a);
- contains the information required under condition C7; and
- has been submitted to the Department prior to the commencement of Stage 2 construction works.

Also, I note that the original CCS, relating to Early works and Stage 1, was approved by the Department on 6 July 2021 under PA-5 and updated Stage 1 and Stage 2 works under PA-19 in 2022.

Accordingly, the Department has filed the revised Community Communication Strategy: Stage 2 Works, dated February 2025 for our information.

I remind you to include author's detail in the future revision(s) of the CCS.

Also, you are reminded to facilitate communication between the Applicant, the relevant Council and the community (including adjoining affected landowners and businesses, and others directly impacted by the development), during the design and construction of the development and for a minimum of 12 months following the completion of construction of each relevant stage.

Please note that if there are any inconsistencies between the revised CCS and the conditions of consent, the conditions will prevail.

Also, please make the revised CCS and the Department letter available for public access on the project website as per condition A21.
