RE: Martin Place Metro Station Precinct: Heritage Interpretation Plan – Compliance with Development Approval Conditions (Conditions A27 and A28)

Thank you for the submission of the Heritage Interpretation Plan to satisfy conditions A27 and A28 of the State Significant Development approval granted by the Department of Planning (SSD 9270 & SSD 9326) for Sydney Metro Martin Place Integrated Station Development.

Please be advised that I have reviewed the submitted *Sydney Metro Martin Place Integrated Station Development – Heritage Interpretation Plan* Issue P11, prepared by Tanner Kibble Denton Architects and Balarinji, dated 17 November 2020.

The submitted documentation is considered acceptable, however, I provide the following comment.

- The document indicates that a number of items have been salvaged during the course of the project. Some of these items have been handed over to Sydney Living Museums and some are retained with Sydney Metro and will remain in storage until a later date. It is recommended that consideration be given to hand over all salvaged items to Sydney Living Museums or utilise them as part of the interpretation. Alternatively, should this not be possible, the salvaged items should be stored within the project area, with a detailed inventory prepared and retained with the precinct management, as there is a greater chance of items retained at off-site locations to be damaged or lost.
