Out of Hours Work (OOHW) Request, Condition C5(d)

Dear Mr Kavanagh

I refer to your OOHW request dated 24 July 2024 seeking the Planning Secretary's approval under condition C5(d) of SSD-9343.

I note the OOHW request:

- was reviewed by the Applicant, and no issues were raised to the Department;
- indicates that previously approved OOHW, issued under SSD-9343-PA-101, could not proceed due to specific process issues;
- is for one (1) night only to undertake upgrades to the existing Sydney Water mains associated with the Hermitage Road footpath works;
- Is aligned with Sydney Water's requirements to undertake proposed OOHW within specified timelines and date;
- has been submitted to the Department before conducting the proposed OOHW; and
- is for the period outside standard construction hours from 7pm Wednesday 31 July 2024 to 4am Thursday 1 August 2024.

As nominee of the Planning Secretary, I approve the updated OOHW request, under condition C5(d) of SSD-9343, outside standard construction hours from 7pm Wednesday 31 July 2024 to 4am Thursday 1 August, subject to:

1. Notifying the affected surrounding residents via emails/letter drops, about the upcoming OOHW and changes to work hours, prior to commencement of the works, as per the timeline specified in the project *Community Communication Strategy*.
2. Providing affected residents the contact details including phone number of the Site Manager so that potential safety and/or environmental concerns, if any, can be lodged, investigated and responded to promptly.
3. Implementing all reasonable and feasible noise control measures including relevant staff/employee induction, briefing, and effective supervision.

4. Managing any community or stakeholder complaints or concerns as per your established complaints management system under the project *Construction Environmental Management Plan* and *Community Communication Strategy*.

Please notify the Department if the OOHW could not be conducted due to inclement weather, logistics, road permit approvals, or any other justified reasons.

Also, please make the OOHW request with supporting documents available for public access on the project website at the earliest convenience.
