I refer to the request for comments on the SEARs for the redevelopment at the Australian Museum. We have reviewed the provided documentation and only have one minor request at this stage. We have an underground cabling project that will involve extensive duct line construction works along College street for the next 18 months. In this regard I would request that in the SEARs provided, that Ausgrid is noted as a stakeholder that requires consultation as part of their development works. There will be significant amounts of construction occurring within College St, including road closures, therefore it would be beneficial to understand the Museum's construction program and methodology in order to reduce the cumulative impacts of construction in the area as much as possible.
