**Chatswood Education Precinct (SSD-9483)  
C6(d) Variation to Construction Hours**

I refer to your submission to the Planning Secretary requesting to vary the construction hours specified in condition C4, Schedule 2 of the project Development Consent for the Chatswood Education Precinct (SSD-9483).

The OOHW are proposed to occur until 30 June 2022. As nominee of the Planning Secretary I do not approve this request at this time.

I note that on 11 February 2022, a new *COVID-19 Development – Construction Work Days Order* (the Order) was gazetted by New South Wales Government which permits building, or demolition works, that are subject to a consent to occur on a Saturday and Sunday. On this basis, you may vary construction work hours in accordance with the Order which is **in effect until 31 March 2022**. This date may be subject to change as the NSW Government continues to implement its COVID-19 recovery plan, and I remind you to plan your construction program accordingly.

Also, any future request for OOHW beyond 31 March 2022 will need to demonstrate compliance with the conditions of consent and contain appropriate management measures to mitigate the continuing impacts of OOHW on the community and other stakeholders.
