Hi Mandana

The exhibited documents were reviewed by our archaeologist and BCD had no issues relating to ACH. The documented consultation was compliant with guideline procedures. There was no disagreements about the proposed mitigation of findings which consist of 7 sites being subject to artefact collection and relocation. They all consist of isolated finds except for 1 site which has 2 artefacts. Findings overall are insignificant. The management actions will be conducted through a Heritage Management Plan. The issues raised by Orange LALC (OLALC) for the project are the same as the OLALC issues raised for the Mine project. The issues are addressed in the ACH assessment report for the pipeline.
