Jindera Solar Farm (SSD-9549) EIS Exhibition

I refer to your email of 10 October 2019 to the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (DPIE) Water and the Natural Resources Access Regulator (NRAR) about the above matter.

The following advice for you to consider is from DPIE Water and NRAR. Please note the Department of Primary Industries (DPI) and Crown Lands now provide a separate response.

Post approval

- The proponent must obtain relevant approvals and licences under the Water Management Act 2000 before commencing any works which intercept or extract groundwater or surface water (including from on-site dams where necessary) or for any works which have the potential to alter the flow of floodwaters.
- The proponent should prepare a Construction Environmental Management Plan and an Operational Management Plan. This should address erosion and sediment control requirements, and water supply arrangements and associated infrastructure for the project.
- The proponent should ensure watercourse crossings and other works within waterfront land are designed in accordance with the Guidelines for Controlled Activities on Waterfront Land (NRAR 2018).
- Soil and Water Management Plan (SO1) and Erosion & Sediment Control Plan (BD13) as proposed are to be developed in consultation with DPIE Water.
