Dear Dean,

On 11<sup>th</sup> March, 2021, I inspected the large Lemon Scented gum, Chinese elm and the construction plans that will be taking place around these trees. Due to the significantly close proximity of excavation works around these trees the chance of survival is minimal. As per the construction plans the excavation works will completely damage the root zones. The only option would be to remove both trees. To compensate for the removal of these trees, more established trees need to be planted in the land scaped areas. All remaining trees within close proximity of excavation works will need to be soil injected with fertilizer and ongoing inspection for root damage once excavation works commence.
