Unexpected Finds Submission Condition C25**

I refer to your correspondence dated 31 August 2021 regarding unexpected archaeological finds at the above project site.

I note that the correspondence included an *Addendum to the GML Historical Archaeological Assessment and Research Design* for the project and set of a number of commitments relating to community engagement, conservation and interpretation of the archaeological artefacts salvaged at the site.

I have carefully considered the information provided and the advice of Heritage NSW. As delegate of the Planning Secretary, I advise that construction works may recommence subject to compliance with the *Addendum to the GML Historical Archaeological Assessment and Research Design* prepared by Lantern Heritage dated 24 August 2021. In addition, within one month of the recommencement of works, details of proposed public consultation regarding the archaeological program must be finalised in consultation with Heritage NSW and submitted to the satisfaction of the Planning Secretary.

You are reminded that a Heritage Interpretation Plan must be submitted to the satisfaction of the Planning Secretary prior to the commencement of operation under condition D22 of the consent. The Plan must reflect compliance with the commitments set out in your correspondence and the advice of Heritage NSW provided to date and further consultation required in the preparation of the plan.
