Young High School Library and Joint-Use Community Facility and SSD 9671: Submission of Design Refinement in accordance with Condition B34

I refer to Young High School Library and Joint-Use Community Facility approved on 21 May 2020.

In compliance with Condition B24 and relating to Condition B34 of the planning approval, School Infrastructure (SINSW) on behalf of the Department of Education, informs DPIE of a change in material selection from the Barestone Fibre Cement Panels (currently specified for the new Library building façade) to the Equitone Fibre Cement Panels.

The change is a result of COVID-19 supply constraints, with the Contractor unable to source the Barestone panels to meet the construction program and required handover date for the school and community. The alternative material Equitone is proposed based on its similarity to the Barestone product.

	The change is a result of COVID-19 supply constraints, with the Contractor unable to source the Barestone panels to meet the construction program and required handover date for the school and community. The alternative material Equitone is proposed based on its similarity to the Barestone product; a picture of the two products is provided below.
	As evident by the photo below, the changes are very minimal and the selection has been endorsed by the Project Architect, Hayball, and Heritage Consultant,

Lantern Heritage as meeting the original design intent already endorsed by Heritage NSW.

- LEFT Currently specified 'Barestone'
- RIGHT Alternative Supply 'Equitone'

With a long lead time for Equitone, we please request your comments, if any, **prior to the end of the year** to ensure that these might be considered prior to placing an order to secure stock for construction mid-next year.

Our Private Certifying Authority (PCA) will not provide a construction certificate until an endorsement from Heritage NSW is provided in line with condition B34 of the development consent (snippet below).
