Development Applications and Modifications Update	Stephanie Partridge – Provided a summary and outlined plans for upcoming development applications and modifications including:  SSD7348 (Modification 6)  New SSD (Buildings 2A & 2C-2E)  New DA (Building 3A)  Alison Kniha – Noted that WaterNSW has seen and responded the proposed modification and SSD as part of the request for SEARs.
Oakdale West Estate and West North South Link Road – Progress and Upcoming Works	Alasdair Cameron – Provided outline of works complete and underway and projected works until the end of the year for both the internal Oakdale West Estate and the West North South Link Road.  Alison Kniha – advised that she had recently been onsite within the WaterNSW corridor in a meeting with Sydney Metro and Robson to discuss methods and best practice for bridgework over the WaterNSW corridor using the WNSLR as an example. Advised was impressed and pleased with the progress to date.
