**Redevelopment of Sydney Football Stadium – Stage 2 (SSD-9835)
Site Contamination and Site Audit Statement, Conditions D53 and D54**

I refer to your submission of the Site Audit Statement (SAS) submitted to the Planning Secretary for information in accordance with condition D53 of the project Development consent for the Sydney Football Stadium Redevelopment – Stage 2 (SSD-9835).

I note that a Section A2 SAS:

- has been prepared and issued by Jason Clay of Senversa Pty Ltd, an independent Site Auditor under the *Contaminated Land Management Act 1997*;
- indicates the site which is assessed by the Site Auditor, being the Sydney Football Stadium and associated public domain areas (excluding Stadium Fitness Facilities and MP1 car parking area), as shown in the Site Plan attached to the SAS; and
- certifies that the site is suitable for intended purpose subject to the Draft Long Term Environmental Management Plan, dated 5 August 2022, prepared by Douglas Partners Pty Ltd.

Also, I remind you to obtain the final consolidated SAS that encompasses the entire project area prior to operations of the stadium, and submit that to the identified agencies including the Department as per the consent requirements.

Please note that if there is any inconsistency between the approved document and the conditions of consent, then the requirements of conditions of consent will prevail.
