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**Sydney Football Stadium Redevelopment – Precinct Village and Carpark (SSD-9835)  
Construction Noise and Vibration Management Plan, Condition B28 and B29**

I refer to a new Construction Noise and Vibration Management Plan (CNVMP) submitted to the Planning Secretary in accordance with condition B28, Schedule 2 of the project Development Consent for the Precinct Village and Carpark site at the Sydney Football Stadium Stage 2 Redevelopment (SSD-9835). I acknowledge and thank you for your response to the Department's review comments for additional information.

I note that the new CNVMP:

- was reviewed by the Applicant, and no issues were raised to the Department;
- was prepared in consultation with the parties required to be consulted with including NSW EPA and nearby sensitive receivers;
