**Sydney Football Stadium Redevelopment - Stage 2 (SSD-9835)
Revised Construction Traffic and Pedestrian Management Plan, Conditions A55 & B32**

Dear Ms O'Neil

I refer to the revised Construction Traffic and Pedestrian Management Plan (CTPMP) submitted to the Planning Secretary under condition A55 of SSD-9835.

I note the revised CTPMP:

- was reviewed by the Applicant, and no issues were raised to the Department;
- relates to the Main works for the Precinct Village and Multi Level Car Park (PV&MLCP);
- has been endorsed by Transport for NSW (TfNSW) and a copy has been submitted to Council for information;
- has been updated due to the recent MOD-10 determination; and
- contains the information as required under condition B32.

Accordingly, the Department has filed the revised CTPMP, Version 07 dated 17 May 2025, for the PV&MLCP main works, for our information under condition A55 of SSD-9835.

I remind you to continue provide the Construction Contractor's direct contact number, as per condition B33, available during all construction hours/stages of the PV&MLCP main works, to TfNSW and the Planning Secretary prior to commencement of any works. Also, I remind you to implement the revised CTPMP effectively to manage potential traffic, transport and safety issues.

You are required to reinstate the footpath and Driver Avenue following the use of the new temporary construction driveway as per the Greater Sydney Parklands requirement.

Please note that if there are any inconsistencies between the revised CTPMP and the conditions of consent, the conditions will prevail.

Also, please make the revised CTPMP publicly available on the project website as per condition A36 of the consent.
