Hello Andy

I have tried to call you about the Walla Walla Solar Farm. I made a submission through the Major Projects Portal before the deadline so I am not sure what has happened.

I did not have a lot of concerns other with the modification other than the traffic movements. My concern was the use of Benambra Road to access the substation. The traffic to the substation was going to be split to be 20 movements through the site and the remainder (10) via Benambra Road. I would presume that the applicant would need to build their internal road to a reasonable standard. If so I don't see the sense in using Benambra Road at all and therefore all traffic should run through the site. This would cut down on compliance issues because nearby residents have raised concerns about the use of Benambra Road.
