Subject: Sydney Metro West – WTP – Parramatta – Request for Planning Secretary Agreement on Alternate Timeframe for commencement of works – Condition A9

Dear Mr Butler,

Thank you for submitting the 'Request for commencing Heavy Vehicle Haulage prior to timeframes stipulated for dilapidation reports under Condition A9' dated 18 May 2026, in accordance with Condition A9 of SSI 10038.

Sydney Metro has requested Planning Secretary agreement to operate heavy vehicles on the roads listed below prior to the timeframe specified in Condition D88 for submission of the Road Dilapidation Report to the Relevant Road Authority, being City of Parramatta Council (CoPC).

Roads Subject to the Agreement

- Macquarie Lane from Macquarie Street to Smith Street
- Smith Street from Macquarie Lane to George Street
- Macquarie Street from O'Connell Street to Macquarie Lane

I note the request and supporting documentation outline that the proposed works involve the use of alternate heavy vehicle access routes to the Parramatta Construction Site, including additional local roads not previously identified.

I further note that the Road Dilapidation Report has been completed and provided to CoPC on 12 May 2026, and that the request seeks to commence works as soon as practicable.

I also note that the request and supporting documentation provide justification for the proposed timeframe, following the demobilisation of the bridge over the Parramatta station box which has constrained site access.

As nominee of the Planning Secretary, I agree to the proposed commencement of works prior to the timeframe stipulated under Condition D88, in accordance with Condition A9.

Please note that separate approval is required under Condition D86 prior to any use of these local roads.
