Dear Mr. Clark

I refer to your submission requesting approval of the Construction Traffic and Transport Management Plan (CTTAMP) Stage B, revision 1, dated 1 August 2025 as required by conditions C6 and C8.

I note the CTTAMP has been:

- developed in consultation with Transport for New South Wales and local councils; and
- endorsed by the ER.

While the CTTAMP broadly responds to the information required by the conditions of approval, it does not include specific measures to mitigate Stage B's potential impacts. The CTTAMP does confirm that those details would be contained in Precinct Traffic Management Plans, which are related to and subordinate to the CTTAMP. To ensure that sufficient mitigation measures are included in the CTTAMP and its subordinate documents, I issue a direction to submit the Precinct Traffic Management Plans for the Planning Secretary's approval, on the terms set out in Attachment 1.

Accordingly, as nominee of the Planning Secretary, I approve the Construction Traffic and Transport Management Plan (CTTAMP) Stage B, revision 1, dated 1 August 2025.

Please ensure you make the document publicly available on the project website at the earliest convenience.

Planning Secretary's Direction

As nominee of the Planning Secretary, I direct ARTC as follows in **Table 1**:

Table 1: Directions

	Direction
1	You must consult with Transport for NSW and relevant Councils regarding all PTMPs works prior to submitting the PTMPs to DPHI.
2	You must not undertake any project-related heavy vehicle movements relevant to each PTMP until that PTMP has been approved by the Planning Secretary.
3	You must implement the approved CTTAMPs, PTMPs and TMPs during construction.

In this direction, terms and expressions have the following meanings in **Table 2**:

Table 2: Definitions

Term or Expression	Meaning
CTTAMP	The Construction Traffic, Transport and Access Management Plan required by Conditions C6 and C8 of the Project Approval and as approved by this letter.
DPHI	The NSW Department of Planning, Housing and Infrastructure
Heavy vehicle movements relevant to each PTMP	Any heavy vehicle movements for the purpose of the project within the project stage and geographical area covered by a particular PTMP.
Project	All works and activities approved under SSI-10055
Project approval	Instrument of approval SSI-10055 dated 8 October 2024
PTMP	Precinct Traffic Management Plan as described in Section 6.1 of the CTTAMP
Relevant council	As defined in the project approval.
Submit to DPHI	The lodgement of a document to DPHI using the NSW Major Projects Planning Portal.
TMP	Traffic Management Plan as described in Section 6.2 of the CTTAMP
