Description of proposal

Development of a new 900 megawatt underground pumped hydro-electric power station, upper dam and reservoir, lower dam and reservoir, main access tunnels, water intake structures, spillway, Macleay River pump facility, grid connection and ancillary infrastructure.

About the exhibition

An exhibition process allows any individual or organisation to have their say about a proposed development.

The Department of Planning and Environment (Department) has received a Critical State significant infrastructure application for the abovementioned proposal. The application, environmental impact statement, and accompanying documents are on exhibition from **Tuesday 19 September 2023** until **Monday 16 October 2023**. At the time of publishing this advertisement, the Minister for Planning and Public Spaces has not directed that a public hearing should be held.

Controlled Action under Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999 (EPBC Act)

Development in NSW can be subject to Commonwealth legislation, depending on the circumstances.

The Commonwealth Minister for the Environment and Water has decided that the proposed development – known as Oven Mountain Pumped Hydro Energy Storage Project (2020/8850) for Commonwealth purposes – is a "controlled action" under the EPBC Act.

The EPBC Act Part 3, Division 1 controlled provisions are:

- Sections 12 and 15A (World Heritage);
- Sections 15B and 15C (National Heritage); and
- Sections 18 and 18A (Listed threatened species and communities).

The proposed development (2020/8850) will be assessed under Part 5 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*. The assessment will be in accordance with the Bilateral Agreement between NSW and the Commonwealth, made under the EPBC Act. The assessment will be done in the manner specified in Schedule 1 of the Bilateral Agreement. This means the project will be assessed against the requirements of both acts.
